

Village of Wayne
Regular Council Meeting
APRIL 20TH, 2022

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Lee present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, and Young present. Young moved and Lee second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Boyer moved and Young second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Katy Foster spoke with council and had some questions about the drainage project and her concerns about easement and drainage on her property. The village solicitor will inform those impacted before the project starts. Kathy also had concerns about vandalism in the park.

Police Chief reported have not received any applications for the part time positions as of yet.

Mayor reported Joe and Terry have been working on the ball fields and the park bathrooms have a fresh new paint and the new partitions have been installed as well.

Mayor reported that spoke with the Mayor Tammy Kreais from Bradner and is interested in sharing a street sweeper however waiting to hear back from Risingsun. Mayor also spoke with the courts and adult probation is set up to sweep the curbs on a Saturday in May. Vandersall discussed what he had found so far on street sweeper prices. Currently waiting on the quote from TJD for street sweeping.

Nothing yet on lighting contract for the village. Mayor and council discussed the lighting on the concession stand (power for camera) and things are moving forward. Had 2nd reading Ordinance 5-22-743: Street Lighting assessment for 2023 for \$14,000. The trees on Bryant St have been removed. The bid opening for the Storm Sewer Project was April 12, 2022 at 9:30 a.m. village hall. The Village received 3 bids for the project: B. Hill'z Excavating Inc \$304,426.00, Jim Palmer Excavating Inc \$351,377.75, and Edward Kelly & Sons Inc \$385,416.00. Choice One created a bid tabulation and analysis for council with the original bid documents with their recommendation for the award of contract. Vandersall moved and Gross second to give Notice of Award for the Storm Sewer Project to B. Hill'z Excavating. All yeah, M/C.

Mayor and Council discussed to start planning the Memorial Day service and will make sure Joe and terry get the flags up soon for Memorial Day.

No further business, Young moved and Lee second to adjourn. All yeah, M/C.
