

Village of Wayne
Regular Council Meeting
MAY 4TH, 2022

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Lee present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, and Young present. Boyer moved and Wildman second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Gross moved and Young second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Police Chief reported caught the person on the green four-wheeler going thru the park and spoke with the juvenile. Police Dept. has started code enforcement.

Mayor reported have not heard back from Risingsun Mayor on street sweeper. The quote from TJD came back at \$285 an hour and looking at 5 hours each time. Vandersall reported that seen some street sweepers on GovDeals.com but no to close (MI & IL) used for around \$17,000 up to \$32,000 and new ones are over \$100,000. The one street sweeper at \$17,000 had a vacuum in the rear that could use to vacuum out the storm drains in town. Lee moved to spend \$20,000 on a street sweeper, no second motion dies. Council discussed more and need to double check with Bradner on pricing, etc. Also discussed if the City of Fostoria had a contract deal like Bowling Green for street sweeping. Fiscal Officer will get ahold of City of Fostoria to check. Gross moved and Vandersall second to authorizing the Mayor to approach Bradner Council/Mayor to inform that the Village of Wayne is looking to put \$20,000 towards a joint contract with Bradner for a street sweeper contingent on hearing back from City of Fostoria if rent, etc. All yeah, M/C.

Nothing yet on lighting contract for the village. Mayor reported Edison still working on the concession stand electric transfer to the Village. Gross moved and Boyer second to pass Ordinance 5-22-743: Street Lighting assessment for 2023 for \$14,000. All yeah, M/C. Fiscal Officer reported that there is a Pre-Engineering meeting for the retention pond project May 6th at 11:00 a.m. and the Village Hall. Fiscal Officer presented council with a couple quotes on new mower for the Village. The Village owns the current grasshopper mower so, no need to buy out the contract on that one. Redline quote for a Grasshopper 61" cut was \$11,383 and Shank's Farm Service LLC quote for a County Chipper Boss XL was \$12,717.38. Young moved and Lee second to approve and purchase the mower from Redline at \$11,383. All yeah, M/C. The current mower will become the back up mower to replace the old snapper mower.

Fiscal Officer will be meeting with GovDeals on May 5th at 10:00 a.m. to be trained and get the fire truck posted for auction. Young moved and Boyer second to approve the Financial Report for April 30, 2022. All yeah, M/C. young asked about the one restroom in the building that is closed currently. Fiscal Officer responded the bathrooms at the hall are currently getting repainted one at a time.

Vandersall reported to council that the Fire Dept. will be doing their annual Car Show on July 9, 2022. Center St. from Main St. to Bryant St. will be closed for the show as well as each side of North St. at Center St.

No further business, Lee moved and Young second to adjourn. All yeah, M/C.
