Had 1st reading resolution 7-20-2020: Wood County EMA: Emergency Management for 2 yrs. Ohio EPA is revocating/terminating the water/sewer shut off order from March 2020. This becomes effective July 10, 2020. Mayor will speak with solicitor about past due accounts and what the village can do (payment plan, etc.).
