JUNE 19th, 2019

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Bechstein absent, Zeigler absent, Gross present, Morlock present, Camden present, and Wildman present. Minutes were approved as read. Morlock moved and Camden second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Linette Kimner, HPS Team Leader with Works Leads to Independence, and associates spoke with council about Buggy Whip Bakery. WLI will be the new management for the bakery and Buggy whip Facebook page. WLI will be looking at doing a soft opening the week of the Wayne's garage sale days and providing the donuts for the Sorehead 5k. Start with donuts and cookies then progress into possibly pies, etc. Council and WLI threw various ideas around.

Joe reported going to try and fog tonight before the rain and will be taking some vacation Friday thru Sunday however everything is set up and ready and will be home in the evenings. Joe has caution tape around merry-go-round to fix. Some residents reported seeing older kids jumping on it and will let police dept. know. Joe has also coned and cautioned taped down on E. Main behind a catch basin (not near the road) for a sink hole where a water line runs thru to fix.

Camden reported for Park Board that met with the eagle scout on the project in the park. Discussed with the eagle scout and doing a 6-inch border around the big play equipment, mulching, etc. Eagle Scout will be getting quite a bit donated however will be a bit short. Camden moved and Gross second to approve the Village providing up to \$1,000 for the Eagle Scout project with funds coming out of Park Fund and/or General Fund. All yeah, M/C.

Camden moved and Gross second to pass Resolution 6-19-191: Apply/Participate for Wood County Park District Grant 2020. All yeah, M/C. Wildman moved and Gross second to pass Resolution 6-19-192: Code Red agreement with Wood County OH. All yeah, M/C.

The mosquito fogger has been ordered (will work with any chemical) and sprayer w/chemical for spraying into catch basin to help control the mosquito growth which is also part of the mosquito grant. Mayor reported BGSU has started trapping for mosquitos in town. Council discussed more on the smoking of the sanitary sewer/storm sewer and did receive one quote but look more into sub pump hookup than eave spouts. Fiscal Officer will email the company for further quotes. Still waiting to hear on a quote on E. Main for storm sewer and ProSweep when coming into town to sweep curbed streets.

Council agreed to cancel July 3, 2019 due to holiday. Fiscal Officer will put up notices and something in the newspaper.
