Regular Council Meeting
JUNE 21ST, 2023

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross absent, Lee present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, and Young absent. Lee moved and Boyer second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Council discussed having Tyson also look at the dugout roofs to see if they will need redone also. Fiscal Officer will contact Morlock to get the walking trailed sealed.

Mayor brought up about the floor in the village hall. Fiscal Officer will get with Garage Door Coating and get a new quote. Would like to get done yet this year if possible.
