Regular Council Meeting
AUGUST 5TH, 2021

The meeting was brought to order by Council President Gross and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Bechstein absent, Gross present, Morlock present, Lee present, Vandersall present, and Wildman present. Lee moved and Wildman second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Lee moved and Vandersall second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Fire Chief John Houtz reported the truck will be at the Wood Co. Fair Monday night and Aug 21, 2021 for the tractor pulls in Bowling Green, OH. Houtz and council discussed about looking into a new back up mower for the village. The old snapper has seen its days.

Fiscal Officer reported that Joe and Terry have been working on a storm drain repair at the corner of N. Center and North St. (by fire station). Vandersall moved and Lee second to approve Ordinance 8-21-738: Ordinance Authorizing Lot Combination (Wayne). All yeah, M/C. Lee moved and Wildman second to approve Resolution 7-21-715: Authorizing the Village to accept the donation of certain real property for municipal use. All yeah, M/C. Fiscal Officer contacted Advent for camera system for park and concession stand and Northwood Door for bathroom partitions. Village Admin. chose blueberry for the partitions and will be stored to be put in next spring after repainting the bathrooms, etc. this fall and winter.

Lee moved and Morlock second to approve the financial report for July 31, 2021. All yeah, M/C. Lee moved and Vandersall waived third reading rule. All yeah, M/C. Vandersall moved and Wildman second to approve Emergency Resolution 8-21-716: Increase General Fund Park Maintenance to \$15,000.00. All yeah, M/C. Vandersall moved and Lee second to waive third reading rule. All yeah, M/C. Lee moved and Morlock second to pass Emergency Resolution 8-21-717: American Rescue Plan Act. All yeah, M/C.

Wildman reported that the Habitat for Humanity ribbon cutting went well and a nice presentation. Vandersall asked about the Church of Good Sheppard on putting up a couple of banners on the 4-corners, Schoolhouse St., and old water tower. Vandersall said will make sure signs do not interfere with mowing, etc. and council agreed that will be fine to place the banners.

Gross wanted to Thank Joe and Terry for keeping the recycling bin area clean.
