NOTICE TO Grizzly Lake CSD- Delleker WATER CUSTOMERS

THIS IS NOT A HEALTH ALERT

The **Grizzly Lake CSD** is in the process of disinfecting the water distribution system for **Delleker only**, this does not apply to the Crocker-Welch water system. Routine bacteriological samples have shown the presence of coliform bacteria in the system; there <u>have not</u> been any detections of E. Coli. Total coliform bacteria are common in the environment and are not generally harmful themselves. The chlorination process will clean out this contamination as we work to determine and fix the cause. **THIS IS NOT A HEALTH ALERT**.

The District will introduce chlorine into the water system on Friday, October 10th. Customers may notice a smell or taste of chlorine for through next week. Again, this is not a health threat. Customers concerned about drinking tap water with chlorine please contact the District at 832-5225. People with tropical fish should not add to or replace tank water for the next week or until tests show the chlorine level to be below trace amounts. We expect levels of chlorine to be less than 2.0 parts per million during this process. The District will continue testing water samples from the distribution system until there are no total coliform bacteria detected.
