An exhilarating ramble through woodland and along delightful coastline.

4.5 miles/7.2km 2hrs Ascent 480ft/146m Difficulty 1

Paths Clear paths through woodland, along coast and across farmland, quiet lane, 4 stiles

Map OS Explorer 164 Gower Grid ref SS 500864

**Parking** Oxwich Bay

- Walk back out of car park and turn L to crossroads. Turn L here (waymarked 'Eglwys') and pass Woodside Guesthouse and Oxwich Bay Hotel, on your R. This lane leads into woods and up to 6th-century St Illtud's Church, where gate marks end of road and start of path leading out on to Oxwich Point.
- 2 Join path that runs beneath church, and follow it for few paces before going up wooden steps that climb steeply into wood. As footpath levels, bear L to drop back down through wood and around headland until it comes out into open above Oxwich Point.
- 3 Path drops through gorse and bracken to become grassy coast path that runs easily above rocky beach. Keep sea on your L and ignore any tracks that run off to **R**. After approximately 1 mile (1.6km) you'll pass distinct valley that drops in from your R. Continue past this and you'll be funnelled into narrow, fenced section with field to your R. Cross succession of stiles, and

you'll eventually reach path diversion that points you R, away from beach.

- 4 Follow this to stile and broad farm track, where you turn L. Continue up and around to R until you come to galvanised kissing gate. Go through this and keep R to head up lane past some houses to crossroads.
- **5** Turn **R** here and follow road along to fork where you keep R. Drop down to entrance of Oxwich Castle on R. After looking at or exploring castle, turn R, back on to lane, and head down into Oxwich village. Keep straight ahead to car park.
