

## BROAD HAVEN The Haroldston Woods

*A winding path through woodland then an easy stroll above the Haroldston cliffs.*

**3.5 miles/5.7km** 1hr 30min **Ascent** 290ft/88m **▲ Difficulty** 1

**Paths** Woodland trail, country lanes and coast path, no stiles

**Map** OS Explorer OL36 South Pembrokeshire **Grid ref** SM 863140

**Parking** Car park by tourist information centre in Broad Haven

**1** From anywhere in car park, walk towards National Park information centre and follow waymarked path that runs between information centre and coastguard rescue building. Fork **L** at junction with holiday park path and continue to kissing gate, where you cross small footbridge to another junction with path from holiday park. Turn half **R**, through kissing gate, to continue with stream on your **L**.

**2** Cross stream by another bridge and now, with stream and valley floor to **R**, continue easily upwards to T-junction of paths by fingerpost. Turn **R** here, past bench on **R**, and then swing **L** to continue upwards to another junction of paths by small chapel.

**3** Turn **L** to road and then **R** on to it to walk uphill, with church on **R**. Keep ahead at T-junction, then take 1st **L**, towards Druidston Haven. Follow this over cattle-grid to sharp **R-H** bend. Continue for another 300yds (274m) to the Haroldston Chin parking area and gate on **L**.

**4** Go through gate and follow well-surfaced track down towards coast. On reaching cliff tops, bear around to **L** and continue past Black Point.

**5** After passing Harold Stone on **L**, path starts to drop, generally quite easily but there is one steep step. Follow path down to meet road and keep **R** to drop to walkway above beach.

**6** Cross over bridge and then, just before road you are on merges into main road, turn **L** on to tarmac footpath that leads through green and back to car park.
