Lots of snow outside

It's December 12, 2019 and it has been snowing with a fair amount of snow on the ground, bringing to life the Christmas feelings again with the holidays quickly approaching. I feel my emotions rising as the Christmas carols play bringing back memories of when I was a boy in Guyana where most people regardless of their religion celebrated Christmas. Like many celebrations in Guyana, and for many in Guyana, Christmas is a cultural celebration where people greeted each other and exchange gifts. When I arrived in Canada as a boy, I was very surprised to see that Christmas was not as grand as it was in Guyana, a place where I sang all the hymns in school. As an adult in Canada, I even wrote a song called Christmas reminiscing on my Christmas holidays; this song have three versions where the second version is a holiday version called Precious Holidays. Back in those days many people put up a tree, decorate the trees with colorful lights and ornaments, and children put up their stockings believing that Santa will come through the chimney when they are asleep. And for the ones that could not afford a tree, they still celebrated by even putting up a branch and decorating it.

In Canada, we continued our Christmas celebrations and also with Alberta Friends of Guyana Association. Even though many like myself are not Christians, we had Christmas parties for the children, where some of us took turns dressing up as Santa over the years and handing out gifts. Although I'm not a Christian, my family, relatives and I still greet each other with 'Merry Christmas' and exchange presents as a part of a cultural celebration.

During the holidays in 2018, I was very surprised when I turned on the radio one morning, which I rarely did, and a Christmas song, which I never heard before, yelled out 'Put up a tree' with the same tone and melody as my Christmas Rock version song which has been posted on YouTube for years now. I hope these same people are not afraid to stand up and say 'Merry Christmas' since people are being told to say 'Happy Holidays' instead.

Baking during the holidays Pepperpot, Jerk chicken

Baking during the Christmas holidays has always been special to my mom, grandmother and aunts in Guyana, which continued in Canada, England and in New York with our relatives. I have also written articles called the 'the sponge cake' articles on baking.

Celebrate with pepperpot

In Guyana many celebrate the holidays with a big meal such as cooking pepperpot, which is an American Indian dish, curry chicken, chowmein, provisions, and other dishes. And in Canada, we still cook up a storm and bake during the Christmas holidays.

Happy Holidays! What about Merry Christmas?

Today people are encouraged to say Happy Holidays instead of Merry Christmas, even though the holidays surround Christmas and Christmas shopping. And you are encouraged to spend your money throughout the month for Christmas presents? But you are encouraged only to say 'Happy Holidays.' Sounds hypocritical, doesn't it? I will continue to greet people with Merry Christmas.

For Muslims and others that have never had the opportunity before to be a part of a culture that celebrates Christmas, I am encouraging you to greet Christians by wishing them a Merry Christmas - after all the holidays do surround Christmas. Wishing people a Merry Christmas does not mean that you must put up a Christmas tree, decorate it with lights and decorate your home and do everything Christians do. Whoa, I thought. I rarely watch TV or TSN, so for me it was odd to see the words 'Bunch of Jerks' flashed on the screen in the wide-open mall with no volume. The word 'Jerks' triggered of something in my head. Because this magazine can be big - sometimes almost 100 hundred pages - and can take up a lot of my time, sometimes I forget what I'm working on, and a reminder helps. I have been sitting in the same café and same spot for years now watching some of the TSN highlights and I have never seen them flashing 'Bunch of Jerks.' Spiritual Healing by Usheda Akbar-Shanks

Shamanism is pure and simple spirit work used to heal people.

TRADITIONAL TECHNIQUES

On a bread roll rolled out add chicken, slicked onions, garlic, tomatoes. You can add lettuce, pepper and other spices and roll into a wrap





THE 1990s (INDEPENDENT) INDY MUSIC SCENE

On January 5, 2020, two sets of recordings on cassette tapes from 1999 were converted to digital. As of January 5, 2020, these digital files are available. In those days I used the name Fyzal Deen, which is my first and middle name.

For me, this 1990s Indy Music Scene began in 1990 with the song, 'The Birds Won't Come My Way' and another original song, or it may have been in 1989. To mark time, I usually pick something that's familiar with me, whether it's a phrase, word, or some kind of similarities; that does not mean that I am paranoid as my stalker that sends messages to me through the website says. At the time, in 1989/1990, I was working in Fort McMurray when I wrote the song, 'The Birds Won't Came My Way.' After I had gone out to a junkyard with a friend who was looking for a car engine, and in the distance there were lots of birds, and everything seems polluted, I was inspired and wrote the song. When I hear about pollution it always triggers of the song 'The Birds Won't Come My Way', marking that time period.

This 1990s Indy scene continued throughout the entire 1990s while I was working mainly as a computer programmer and also went back to school. For example, I recall pulling into the back alley many times to and enter Beta Studio, and also walking up a set of long stairs when entering Big Records.

I never pursued playing in clubs. I had focused mainly on songwriting and recording, although I was involved in some live performances such as at the Legislative grounds, in B.C and other places, and did some traveling for a year with a band.

In the studios I had met many session musicians whom I learned a great deal from being in the professional studios. Although the 1999 project was not completed, it's all a part of my experience in the music scene, and I have tapes of my songs and my experiences.

UPDATING CASETTES TO DIGITAL FOR EASY ACCESS AND DISTRIBUTION

On January 5, 2020 and shortly before, I had decided to convert many of the tracks recorded in 1999 that were on tapes to a digital format.

I call one set of recordings:

TRUE LOVE FYZAL DEEN AT RED STRIPE IN 1999 THE 1990s Indy Music Scene

The first set of tracks were recorded at Alberta Sound Engineering in 1999 and mixed down at Red Stripe in British Columbia in 1999.





The second set of tracks were recorded at Power Sound Studios in 1999 and I called the project:

FYZAL DEEN AT POWER SOUND STUDIOS IN 1999 THE 1990s Indy Music Scene

Tracks were recorded in 1999 but the projects were not completed as originally planned

In 1999 my projects were not completed due to unforeseen setbacks. Many tracks were mixed down and used as band tracks for playing over the years. Most of the vocals were not produced as planned and thus the vocals and mix are rough. This was a part of what I refer to as the 1990s Indy Music Scene.

As a part of this 1990 scene, I wrote many songs and entered some professional recording studios. Prior to this, I had done some home recordings using 4-tracks and ADAT machines where three tapes were recorded in 1994 and 1995. Before entering a professional studio, I always had a few versions of my songs recorded using multiple instruments and a drum machine.

The converted tracks from tape to digital are not good quality, but they mark a period of time and familiarity for me.

Modifying lyrics

Being an Indy Artist, over time some of the lyrics on some of my songs were modified as seen in my song / lyric book, and some of my songs have different versions, for example 'Wide Eyed Innocent', and '2Can Play' (Party Till We Fell Alright). A change in lyrics in the song 'Sometimes' is in the second line where I later replaced the line 'I can't help the way I feel for you' for 'Sometimes I hear voices calling my name' which rhymes with the first line. Speaking of Wide Eyed Innocent, recently in my neighborhood I heard a similar bass line to my song Wide Eyed Innocent, but of course modified.

Below are songs on the digital conversion that took place on January 5, 2020, converting songs from tape to digital. Although the conversion began on Jan 5 2020, other format(s) took place within a few days after, along with some cleaning up. In the future the order of the songs may change and the recordings with more conversations will take place.

Fisal Ally played guitar during the sessions.

During this time, I had some vocals coaching from an amazing singer named Anna Beaumont, so it was unfortunate that I could not have completed the project due to unforeseen setbacks. However, the tracks on tapes and the 4 songs CD marks that period in time for me even if the mixes are rough and a bit noisy.

Around the mid 1990s, one of my brother's friends, Russel Althouse, from his work place had brought over his guitar and we were playing 'The Birds Won't Come My Way.' I had asked Russel to come up with a lead for this song and he played a picking pattern for the lead, which I liked. Although I did not use the picking pattern as the lead for this song, I began using the pattern which Russel had played but with my own modifications and triads throughout the entire song.

Red Stripe

For this project, I mentioned Red Stripe on the CD because it was a memorable experience flying to British Columbia to enter this studio and download the tracks that was recorded in Edmonton, AB, Canada. Although I do not remember, I believe that I had done some quick vocals at Red Stripe. I did not have an opportunity to complete the vocal production in Edmonton.

The song 2CanPlay / Party till we feel alright

The song 'Party till we feel alright' or 'We party till we feel alright' or simply the Party till song (there was no need to say party until...simply party till works), was originally called 2 Can Play. The original version, 2CanPlay is still used. Around 1997 while recording this same song at Beta studio, the producer, Gary Koliger, had mentioned that the song could be called 'Dance all night.' This song has many names. It's a song about people that party their life away - certainly not about me as I'm not a party kind of person, as I had to spend lots of time as home writing songs, recording and writing books. For this song I have been playing the different guitar parts, which is three or four parts (rhythm, riff, a lead riff, lead guitar). I had surprised myself being able to come up with all of those parts playing on top of each other. It's alot of work creating riffs and leads, and I could not have done this if I was into drugs, alcohol, hanging out at bars and watching hours of sports on TV. The version on this party till song which drummer, Tim Lent, had played on around 1998 in Big Records is one of my favorites for this song. There are about 6 versions of this song recorded in the 1990s as part of my 1990s Indy Music Scene.


