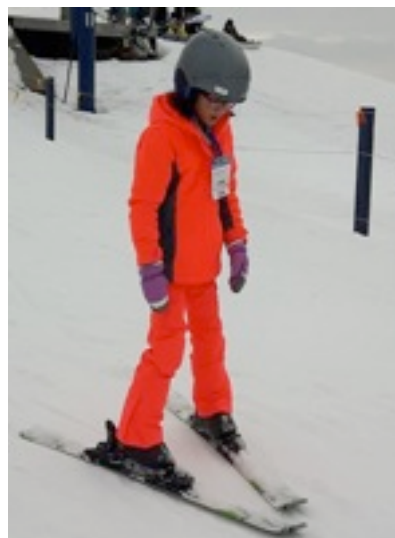
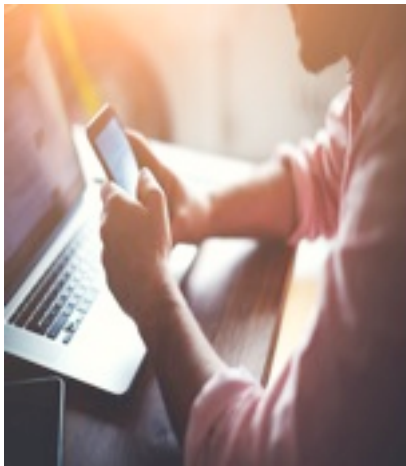

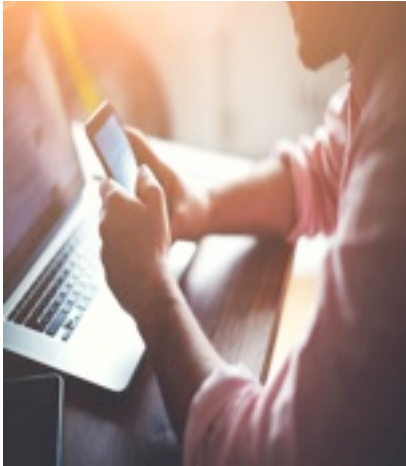

Roti also known as chapati is a flat bread, which many uses on a daily basis. It is often broken into pieces and ate with many dishes such as okra, spinach, curry and stew. It can be used as a wrap, for example, boneless curried chicken with potatoes is wrapped in the roti. It's made from flour, rolled flat and then cooked on top of a tawa on the stove. There are different types of rotis such as: paratha roti (plain), dhal puri and sada roti. Dhal puri is a favorite amongst many because of the grinded up peas in the middle. Dhal puri also takes a lot more time to make since the peas has to boiled to the right softness and then grinded up by often using a mill.

He even went further to state that the “United States has the worse educational system known to Science.” He says, “Our graduate compete at the level of third world countries.”

In fact, Kamin was exposed to the vices of alcoholism and brutality her Husband offered on a daily basis.

She was poor, but my memories of her brings back laughter

I like to remember Aunty Kamin's sitting on our yard bench with her contagious humor and laughter as she extolled the virtues of earning her livelihood in the Sugar Estates Backdams as a Weeder. I recall the ideal cutlass { Machete } she gave my Mom to do her Gardening at home. Kamin was poor but would always ensure she brought copious supplies of sweetmeats on Hindu Holidays or observations. Ironically, the media reports indicated she had been murdered after doing her morning Puja within her yard.

The Government demolished her modest home in Montrose She joined the Justice Movement to oppose this discrimination

When Cheddi Jagan stormed the elections in 1992, Kamin was euphoric in her support for her hero, as he became President of Guyana. A few years later, Kamin was to become embroiled in a struggle to reclaim her property, which she had erected after the 1964 racial riots and where she would call her home in Montrose on the East Coast of Demerara. For the very Government she ushered in, chose to dismantle her modest home to facilitate an aggressive regularizing Land survey. Kamin Ganesh would subsequently join my Justice Movement to oppose this formidable but discriminatory process. The only female litigant in a litigation, which engaged the courts for many years with a residue of bitterness she digested to the very end.

She became one of the poor forgotten rural women, but stood tall till the end

Kamin Ganesh belongs to a genre of poor forgotten rural women. I remember her fondly as an aunt but a tower of strength who would prefer to sacrifice what little possessions she had managed to accumulate in the pursuit of Justice. If she could, she would strive to right the wrongs of this world but her compassionate nature allowed reason to prevail in the end. Her credentials may not accommodate academia but provide a concise analysis of human endurance and stamina in face of adversity. A diminutive woman who will always stand tall, for those of us who knew her and her efforts to be independent in a limiting environment.

A woman for all seasons, the hands of a coward ended her life, but she left a rich legacy behind

Death came at the hands of a coward, a creature of malevolence. However, kamin Ganesh has left a rich legacy of struggle and vindication against society and the challenges it pose to our very existence. A woman for all seasons, Kamin Ganesh, fondly known as Aunty kamin.

I had undergone this change many years ago, when I had taken a full three-day seminar from Dr. Deepak Chopra and his team.

A shift in awareness

Becoming aware of what meditating will do for us can motivate us towards a life changing experience.

² *Perfect Health* by Deepak Chopra, p. 8

Some of the benefits from meditating regularly are:

- 1) Relieving stress and anxiousness
- 2) Allows us to let go and wind down
- 3) Achieving stillness and silencing of the mind
- 4) Lowering blood pressure
- 5) Stop judging and blaming

Two techniques I use are as follows

I would like to share two techniques, which I have learned that bring stillness and silence into my everyday life. 1) I had taken the three-day Primordial Sound Meditation seminar in where I had used a mantra to widen the silence gap between my thoughts, and how to remain still and in silence for a period of time. 2) I later learned to quiet my mind by focusing on my breath and breathing.

Some people are very skeptical when they hear the word meditation or mantra. Some believe that it's against their religion. If it's anything, learning to meditate makes me connect better during prayers, by letting go of all the chattering that goes on in my mind, and becoming more relaxed so I could connect and remain focus.

My first experience in meditation was when I was a teenager. I had read in a book on how to focus. I used to focus on a small dot for a few minutes. Later in life, after I had learned to meditate - many years ago from the seminar by Dr. Chopra, and I used to practice my meditation religiously with the mantra that was given to me based on my birthday and my vibrations in the universe. I later replaced the mantra with a phrase used in Islam. I will refer to the mantra as a phrase. Here are four phrases; there are many which you will find on the Internet.

- 1) Om shanti shanti (*Mantra in Sanskrit*)
- 2) Om Namah Shivaya (*Mantra in Sanskrit*)
- 3) Maranatha (*phrase used in Christian meditation*)
- 4) Subhannalah (*phrase used in Islam during zikr and prayers. Zikr is similar to meditation or some say it is a meditation, which is a part of the prayer*)

Using the first method

I commence my meditation by sitting comfortably with my palms on my lap. I close my eyes for a few minutes? What happens? All kinds of thoughts kept coming and going? Of course.

Now, sit, relax and close my eyes again and begin saying my phrase over and over for a few minutes, trying to let go of the thoughts in my head. By saying the phrase over and over, this phrase should replace the stories and blaming that goes on in my head. How does it feel to have such a simple phrase now swirling through my head instead of my rambling thoughts? Good of course. As a beginner, a person's thoughts and rambling stories will surface over and over. When this happens, the goal is to catch yourself and start repeating the phrase over and over again. Buried thoughts, hurts and anger will surface. Let them surface, deal with them and let them go, and then start repeating your phrase over and over.

As I continue to repeat my phrase, I slow it down. Now there will be gaps of silence in between the phrase. I continue to slow down my phrase. Let the silence gaps between my phrase get bigger so I have more silence between my phrase. Let the mantra become slow and fade, so I remain in silence as long as I possibly can. The thoughts will come back. Repeat the process. Over time a person gets better at it. I used to do this for 20 minutes to 45 minutes every morning for a year.

Using the second method

I inhale slowly feeling the air flow through my nostrils, down my throat and into my lungs as my lungs expand. I remain focusing as I exhale slowly feeling the air moving through my lungs, throat and out my mouth. Repeat a few times, keeping my focus on my breath. If my thoughts are on my breath, this means that a person's thoughts are not on the stories and blaming that goes on in the person's head.

The rejuvenating process begins with silence

When your mind is silent, this is when the rejuvenating begins. When my mind is silenced, I make a wish. For example, I wish everyone peace and love. I wish them the best, or I say a prayer now that my mind is silence and not on trivial matters.

For anyone interested in meditation, it's import to seek professional training. For professional training visit www.chopra.com (or go to another reputable website) and sign up for a meditation seminar, where the classes can be done online or in a group, and where you will receive the guidance and expertise of a trained and experienced practitioner so you benefit the most.

Software was installed on its 11 million TVs sold to customers since 2010 and commenced it’s spying in 2014. Vizio had made a lot of money from selling their customers’ data. According to the article: "Consumers didn't know that while they were watching their TVs, Vizio was watching them," the The FTC said.

Samsung has admitted that there are cameras on their TVs, this is an indication that you should not be talking about personal things while watching TV.

About Samsung’s Smart TV privacy policy

This same article states that Samsung’s Smart TV privacy policy explains that “Samsung has made its TV privacy policy easy to find, and compared to other companies, it's much clearer. The most important part reads: "If you enable the collection of information about video streams viewed on your SmartTV, we may collect that information and additional information about the network, channels, and programs that you view through the SmartTV. We will use such information to improve the recommendations that we deliver to you on the SmartTV."

Who can we trust today? We must start thinking for ourselves

With technology anything is possible. I was discussing this problem with a friend and he stated that if there are backup batteries on the TV, then when your TV is off or even if you unplug it thinking that there’s no power, it could be recording your conversations. Samsung says that what’s collected from your TV goes to a third party.

Due to the interaction and connection of people in the cyber world, there have been a lot of harassments, nude pictures taken without consent, and some people are blackmailed for sex and money. And if you are a writer, inventor, a songwriter, a musician and you are creating your art, there are many loopholes and ports that give criminals access to your work, where they can steal your work as you are creating it, and have it copyright, modified and published before you even have a chance.

Technology and the cyber world is great for keeping people in touch as they travel across the globe, or for keeping a watch on children and the elderly, but with all of the corruption in the world, some are misusing technology and the cyber world.

PROMOTING LITERATURE, MUSIC, ARTS

Comparative research on literature, music, commercials by Faisal Ally

The goal in this RESEARCH PROJECT is to study how literature, music, commercials, movies and other areas evolves or mutates from work by independent and also by mainstream musicians and writers. To examine words and phrases. This is done through observations. For an independent artist, I'm using some of my songs for this project since I'm very familiar with my work and could quickly pick out similar ideas and make sense of them. I have been collecting data for the past few years.

One area of my current research uses twelve songs from the Second Edition of my song/lyrics book "Story of my Life." These songs were posted in the Cariwave New Year edition, which was published on January 29, 2017, and there was an explanation about this comparative research. Another area of this research looks at phrases from the Cariwave Magazine. Another area looks at my music and the music of another group.

1) Let's examine the lyrics from the song, "The World's Online "which I had written around 2010. Let's look at the line, "We don't talk anymore, we just text, we say hi and go, no we don't talk." Note: The lyrics were published on January 29, 2017.

Below are some observations.

On January 31, 2017 or and Feb 5, 2017, I heard the phrase in a commercial: "Love that texts less and talks more." Let's examine the line in my song: "We don't talk anymore, we just text." This line seems to be reversed in the commercial and used in the opposite sense: "Love that texts less and talk more."

On Feb 4, 2011, I heard the line "Talk & Text" in a commercial.

Suddenly and immediately after I posted my lyrics, I began to hear about Texting and Talking in the same sentence.

Let's continue.

Look at the words "hi and go" in the line above. On January 31, 2017, I noticed a commercial using the phrase, "stop and go." A few more new commercials came out and used the same line or variations. Then on Feb 21, I heard the line "banana and go." For this report, I replaced the name used in the commercial for banana.

I do not listen to the radio unless I'm somewhere and the radio is on. About 6 months, a song coming over the air was singing this phrase over and over: We don't talk anymore. I believe this is identical or almost identical to the phrase I just gave in the line above. Is it a coincidence that two songs are so similar?

2) Observations from my song called My Home. My lyrics are: Windows of the past, thank you. I'm still walking in the park and throwing stones." This line was also written out in big writings in the *2017 Cariwave Magazine New Year's Edition* starting on P. 22.

Below are some observations on similarities to "Windows of the Past" mainly coming from commercials. Notice the use of the word "past."

Feb 26, 2017: Every homeless person has a past.

Feb 27, 2017: On the news, the banner said "Stuck in the past"

Feb 27, 2017: On the episode that was showing during the news, the narrator says: "Preserve the past..."

(I did not watch TV for a few days, so I may have missed more)

Mar 4, 2017: On a commercial: Places that echoes a past and preserves the future.

Mar 5, 2017: On a different commercial the phrase is: It has taken everything a family can throw at it. (*Note the similarities about throwing something*)

3) Observations from my song called We're on our way (Champs / Victory). My lyrics are as follows:

I'll give all my love to you, I'll bring victory to you

We'll win, we'll win, we'll win I'll fight all my life for you...

You can't escape from reality, getting by can be so hard

Take a step we'll find a way, everyday can be a better day

One for all and all for one, when we fall we'll get up back Make a move, we're ready to go, we're on our way, we're on our way...

My first observations mainly from commercials:

On Jan 30, 2017: "All for one and one for all" (Note: that the lyrics from the song above was published on the January 29 Cariwave New Years Edition Magazine)

Jan 2017: win, win, win. *Note the three win's in line two.*

Feb 21, 2017: "It's all of this and all of that." (*This may demonstrate how a phrase can evolve*)

Feb 26, 2017: "Escape reality" are words written in big letters on a commercial. In my song I state, "You can't escape from reality."

4) My song title: Sunshine's Back Again."

Feb 20, 2017 on a new TV series, first episode, states, "The sun will always shine again." *Note: This was more like a dub onto the video and not someone engaged in a conversation.*

5) Let's examine the lyrics from my song: Space & Time. The lyrics are: Burning, burning, burning through the night, Burning, burning, burning through the night, Burning through the night, Burning through the night That's right!

A day or two after, a TV host was going on and on about burning with lines similar to: I'm burning up and number of times and then said something like, acid burning through my head.

6) From my song True Love, there's the line "It's like magic in the air, Just like magic in the air. On Feb 1, 2017, for the first time I heard the lyrics and music for the line "24 karat magic in the air" on a Grammy Trailer. This is very similar to the lyrics and melody from True Love. Also the intro to this song, has some similarities to the intro to True Love. What was very interesting is, last Wednesday on March 1, 2017, I was at West Edmonton Mall, and a children's hockey game was taking place. I stopped to watch. A minute later, it was face off and the music started, and it was the short piece of the song above that sounded like my song.

7) From my song: The lyrics are: Wild Wild Wild you're hot like fire, wild wild wild you're a burning desire. A few months back, a song playing in the restaurant I was having lunch at had some similarities to my song.

Also a song came out that's called Wild.

8) From my song "Sometimes" with the lyrics "Baby I love you", I heard a similar line with the exact lyrics and melody around August 2016.

Some similarities between the Cariwave Magazine and some commercials

9) In the November 2016 Cariwave Edition in an AD, I emphasized on the words "Be there!"

On February 9, 2017, a commercial used the same phrase: "Be there!"

On Feb 21, 2017, another commercial used “Be there instead.”

10) In the Cariwave Magazine New Year Edition on p.11, I emphasized on Need a getaway to unwind, relax and rejuvenate?

A commercial on Feb 11, 2017 used the exact phrase: “Unwind, relax and rejuvenate.

On March 4, 2017, a commercial used the words “to relax and unwind”

11) In the November 2016 Cariwave Magazine Edition on p.8, I used the words “Keeping our dreams alive...We believe in you and your dreams.” In a commercial on February 9, 2017, it used the words “I believe in you.”

In summary, this gives an idea of the data that's being collected to study the evolution and mutating of phrases, through the use of methods, and works by writers and musicians.

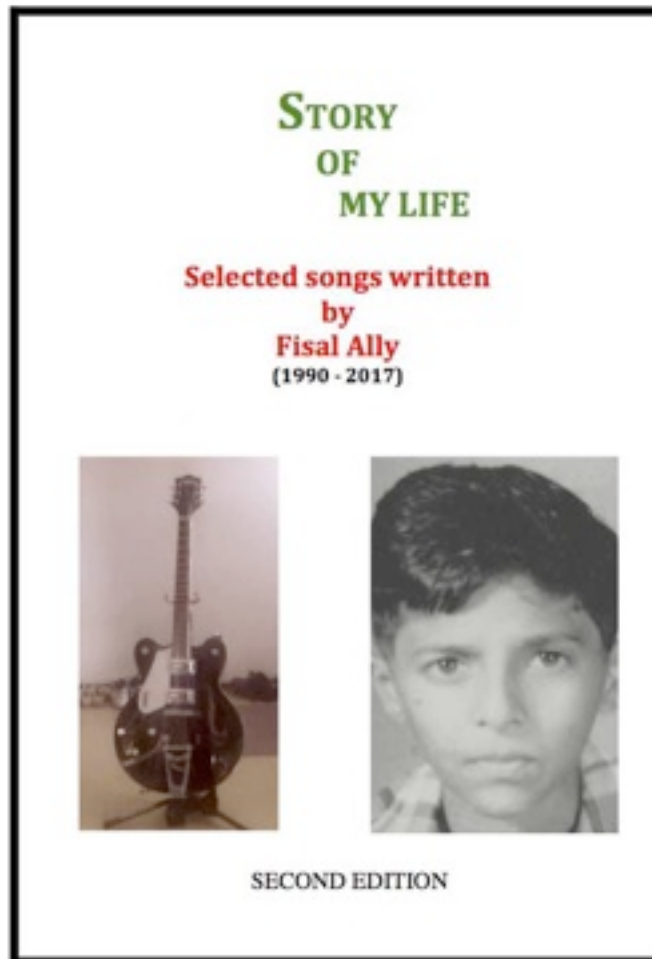

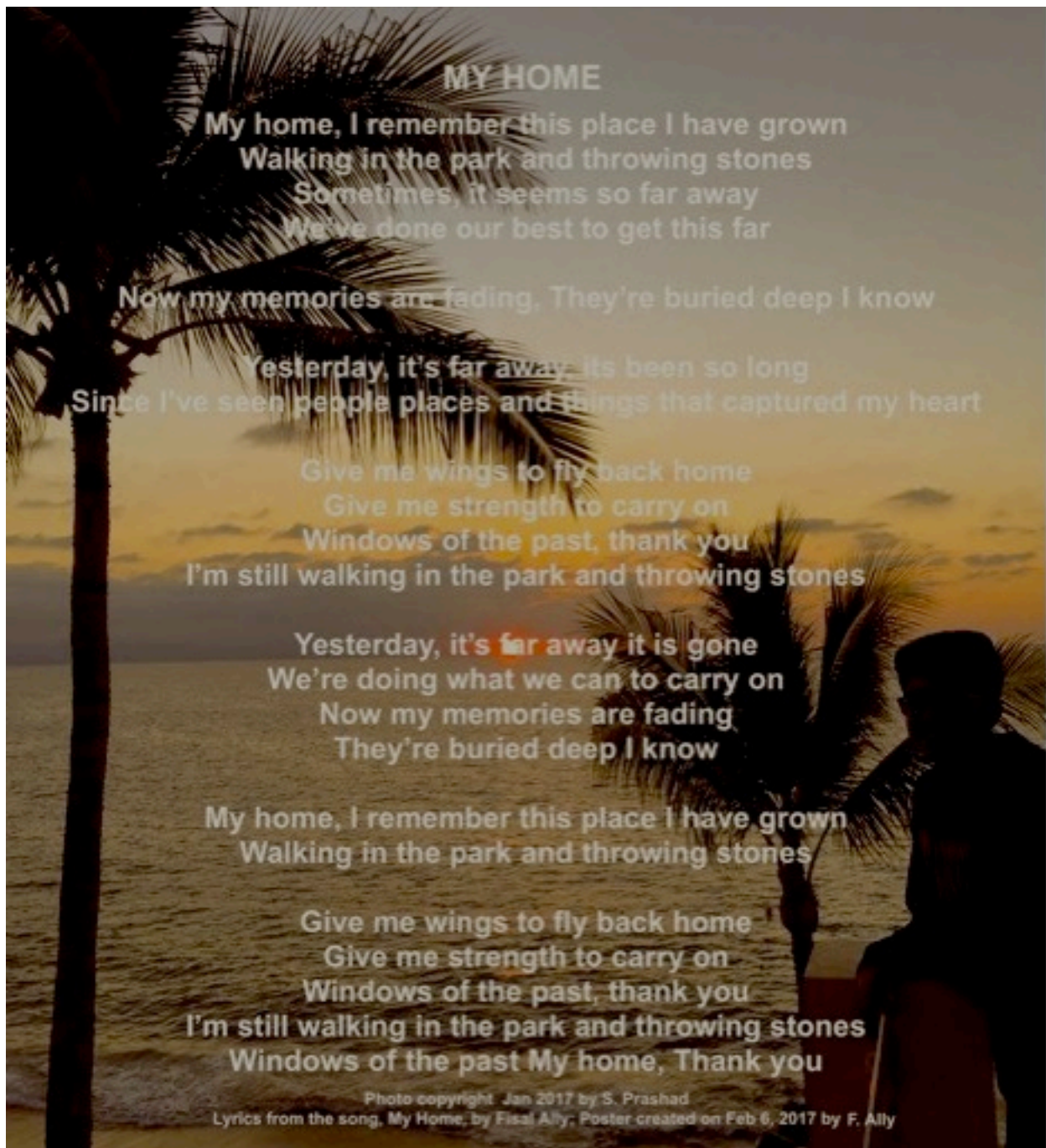


