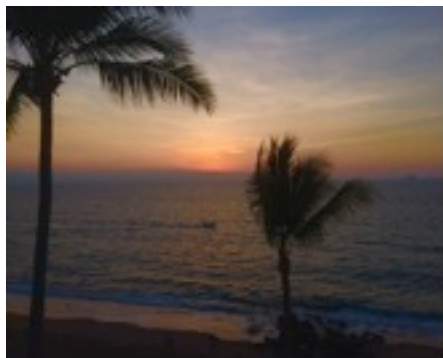

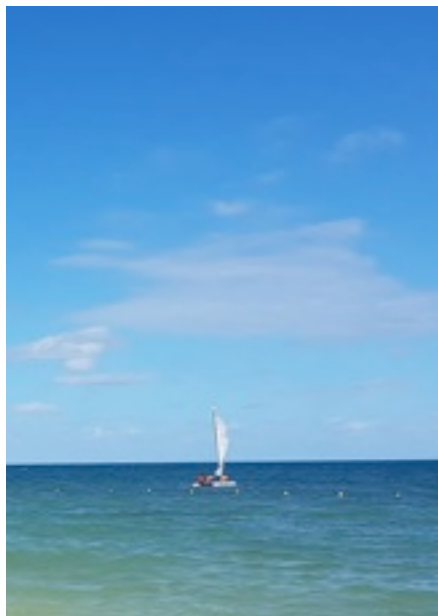

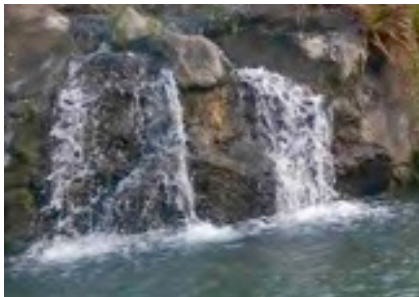

THE ABOLITIONIST SERIES

PART V - William Lloyd Garrison Biography

Publisher, Journalist, Activist (1805–1879)

William Lloyd Garrison had become an American abolitionist and had started *The Liberator*, an abolitionist paper in 1830, and had fought to put an end to slavery.

After his father abandoned the family when he was three years old, he, his mother and siblings had lived in poverty. He had also spent some of his life living with a Baptist.

At the age of thirteen, he became an apprenticeship writer and editor for the *Newburyport Herald*. At age twenty, he purchased the *The Newburyport Essex Courant* and had changed the name to *The Newburyport Free Press*. The paper soon folded. He moved to Boston and became “a journeyman printer and editor for the *National Philanthropist*, a newspaper dedicated to temperance and reform.”

HE STARTED HIS OWN PAPER CALLED THE LIBERATOR

In 1828, he became the editor for the *Genius of Emancipation* in Vermont and had joined the abolitionist movement. In 1830 he started his own abolitionist paper, and called it *The Liberator*. After taking a trip to England in 1833, he founded the American Antislavery Society. In August of 1847, Garrison and a former slave Frederick Douglass had made “40 anti-Union speeches in the Alleghenies.’ Through the years, Garrison had continued to resist slavery through the *Liberator*.

Years later, in 1865 as the Civil War came to end, he had witnessed complete abolishment of slavery throughout the United States.

BLACK HISTORY

CARTER G. WOODSON

Black History Month is a reminder that throughout history and today, Blacks have made great contributions to our society.

Back in 1915, Carter G. Woodson started the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History (ASALH) which recognized Black Scholars, Historians and son's of former slaves. He then initiated Black History Week on February 12, 1926. During the 1960s Black History Week became Black History Month. Many do not realize some of the great accomplishments made by Blacks, such as the electrical pioneer, Lewis Latimer and many others, that have contributed greatly to the rest of the world.

LEWIS H. LATIMER, THE GENIUS, PAVING THE WAY

Lewis Latimer, born on September 4, 1848 in Chelsea, Massachusetts was the son of George and Rebecca, who had escaped from slavery in Virginia and headed north for freedom and in search of better opportunities for their children.

Lewis Latimer is known for inventing the carbon filament light bulb and for working with great inventors like Alexander Graham Bell and Thomas A. Edison. Latimer had made a break through with his improvement on the light bulb invented by Edison; this improvement to the light bulb was Latimer's most important scientific contribution, which the world cannot live without.

SOME CLAIMED IT WAS LATIMER THAT INVENTED THE TELEPHONE

Some claimed that it was Latimer that invented the telephone and not Bell, but Latimer had often defended Bell's claims in court as being the first to invent the telephone." ...*Continue on p.15*

ARTISTS ALIVE SAMPLING OF SONGS

Sometimes musicians/artists sample songs by other artists. In other words, a phrase, a melody and or riff, which is catchy and is written by another group or artist can bring out another song.

Being granted permission to use these samples is one thing, but sometimes an artist would claim that his or her sample was not used accordingly to the permission that was granted and ends up in court, or his or her sample was used without permission, and thus another court battle.

As mentioned in past editions, sometimes artists' songs are stolen, broken into pieces and sold off without them even knowing it. Unfortunately, today, many popular mainstream artists are being sued by other artists, including independent artists, for different reasons, such as for their songs being similar to another song, or for using samples without permissions.

As an independent artist with approximately 100 songs, since 2012, I've been hearing many phrases - melodies and lyrics - that are very similar to parts of my original songs. For example in my Christmas CD with 4 songs from the year 2000, I have heard similar phrases from "A Kiss Goodnight" and from "True Love." These songs were also recorded back in the 1990s. When the country group, Lady Antebellum, came out with a song called "Just A Kiss", I recognized the ending to be very similar to mine from "A Kiss Goodnight." From my observation, the ending sounds the same, although they added runs to their singing, and they are amazing singer. Their song also ends with the words similar to my song title and not to their song title. Just recently I heard a phrase from a song by Bruno Mars on a trailer for the Grammys. The song, I believe is called 24 Karat Magic.

I really don't know anything about Bruno Mars, nor listens to his music, so I then went to youtube to listen to his song, and shockingly his opening reminds me of my opening for True Love. His melody for the word "tonight" reminds me of the melody for the words "true love" from my song. Are there any other words close to "true" than "too"? Then in my chorus the lyrics are "It's like magic in the air, like magic in the air." "Like magic in the air" reminds me of "24 karat magic in the air." The melody and lyrics are very close. How is that even possible when True Love was written in the early 90s. I did place my songs in the wrong hands around 2011/2012 in Sturgeon, St. Albert, which is just a few minutes north of Edmonton while in the coffee shop where I had spent a lot of time doing my writing and editing.

A few months back on the news, I heard something very similar by Tegan and Sarah, who are sisters, and who I was hearing about for the first time. The name of my song from the 90s is called "Only a fool breaks his own heart" where the words are "I was a fool for loving you" and theirs is "I was a fool for love." So if you chop off "ing you" from my line, you get their exact line. It's not hard to do that. The words and the melody are almost the same.

These are only some observations. I have heard many more parts of songs by other musicians that are very similar to parts of my songs written back in the 1990s and some written around 2010, years before their songs came out. For example, others have compared my ending of "A Kiss Goodnight" to the ending of "Just A Kiss" by Lady Antebellum, and they say it's the same ending. I believe that my unique creation from many years in creating my original songs - music and lyrics have made it across the globe and have influenced many artists and millions, or should I say a billion, of hearts around the globe? For me this alone is a huge success in itself if others are listening to parts of what I came up with and what I have created in the past. Magic?

LEWIS LATIMER, THE GENIUS

Alexander Graham Bell had hired Latimer to draw up the plans for the new invention, which would communicate two ways, and Latimer would work late at nights to supply Bell with the blue prints for the telephone, which allowed Bell to file his patent on February 14, 1876, by just a few hours in the race against one of his rivals.

Latimer was also connected to another great inventor, Thomas A. Edison. He was on Edison's research team and is known for inventing the carbon-filament light bulb and for the widespread use of the electric light around the world. Although, in 1878, it was Thomas Edison who invented a prototype incandescent light bulb, which was destined to replace candles and gaslight forever, it was Latimer who invented the carbon-filament light bulb in 1897, after thousands of tests. Edison's prototype light bulb used a thin strip of paper, attached to wires, which were enclosed in a vacuum inside a bulb. When electricity flowed into the paper filament it was lit by a glow, but the draw back was when the paper filament burnt out quickly, lasting only about 30 seconds.

Latimer made a break through with his improvement on the light bulb invented by Edison. This improvement to the light bulb was Latimer's most important scientific contribution.

HIS MANY PATENTS HE BROUGHT LIGHT INTO OUR LIVES

His patents were as follows: Water closet for railroad cars on February 10, 1874; improvement on electric lamp on September 13, 1881; process for manufacturing carbon filament on January 17, 1882; arc light globe support on March 21, 1882; patent for apparatus for cooling and disinfecting on January 12, 1886; device for locking hats, coats, and umbrellas on hanging racks on August 25, 1895.
