Here you'll find 4 general categories of funeral services. I've grouped the elements together under the type of service that they're usually associated with. However, this is your roadmap, you can choose whatever elements appeal to you. You don't have to stick to one category. **Circle the ideas that you like, the ideas you would like to include in your plan.**

You'll notice that I've included a category related to home funeral. We don't have time to explore home funeral here but if you would like more information, check the resources.

So far, you have made decisions about disposition, you've looked at your photos and your life and hopefully you've begun to see a pattern of what you value and you've picked out some elements that you'd like to include in your service.
