

Create a roadmap for your loved ones that will guide them to make disposition arrangements and plan an event in your honor.

You should address the following points.

- 1. Body Disposition (traditional burial, cremation, green burial...)
- 2. Final resting place
- 3. Product preferences (type of casket, urn, shroud, etc..)
- 4. Type of service (traditional, formal, celebration of life, private event)
- 5. Would you like a public service followed by a more intimate gathering?
- 6. Provide idea and specific details that you would like included.

Your **goal** is to organize all of the decisions that you've made so far into a cohesive package. At the end of this assignment, you should walk away with a plan that you can hand anyone and be fairly confident that they could follow your lead and create a funeral that would be a reflection of who you are.

There are lots of ways to do this, choose an avenue that works best for you. Here are a few ideas.

- If you're a visual person, online tools like **Canva and Pinterest** allow you to communicate your ideas with the help of pictures. The same thing can be accomplished with a **scrapbook** page if you're not a fan of computers. The example that I've used here was created in Canva.
- Use the worksheets that you've been given in this course, circling options that you find appealing, adding supplementary notes and suggestions.
- If the **written word** works best, write it all out. If possible, add pictures. As the saying goes, a picture is worth a thousand words.
