If you are tired of remitting credit card fees yourself, or are looking to offer a discount to customers paying with cash, the EDGE program is the perfect solution for your business.

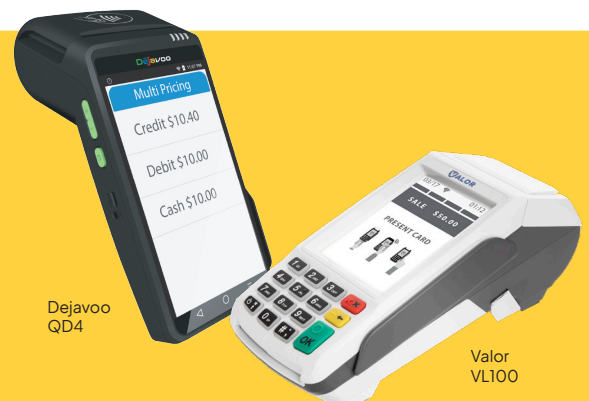
