



# Unicorn Riding Craft Kit

## Materials Needed:

1. Pool noodle, or long stick from outside, or long barbecue skewer from dollar store
2. Large brown paper bag for unicorn head or if using pool noodle, part of the pool noodle becomes the head
3. Ribbon or yarn or cloth for mane.
4. Large googly eyes for eyes (or you can draw some with a black marker)
5. Stapler, glue, packing tape or glue gun (whatever you have available)
6. Yellow/gold piece of paper for horn
7. Yarn/string for reins if you want some

## Instructions:

1. Cut out 2 unicorn heads and ears from a large brown paper bag or large brown piece of construction paper (you need two so you can glue them back to back so your horse has two sides to his head) If you are using a pool noodle – fold a quarter of the pool noodle over and wrap packing tape around it to hold it in place (you can cover the packing tape with ribbon or paper to make it look like a bridal)
2. Glue/staple or hot glue gun ribbon or yarn to the head to make it look like a mane on the top and back of head
3. Give your unicorn a nose, mouth and eyes with a marker or glue pieces on if you prefer
4. Glue a yellow/gold triangle on the front of the head for the unicorn horn
5. If you used paper, glue or tape the barbecue skewer to the head of the unicorn and then glue the other head on top so your unicorn had two sides
6. Ride your unicorn during our unicorn storytime or at Coombs Community Picnic on June 9th or outside or at the beach as much as you want!!
