Species recommendation/ possible alternates

-  Bigleaf maple (*Acer macrophyllum*) (1)
-  Dura Heat river birch (*Betula nigra* 'BNMTF') (1)
-  Persian ironwood (*Parrotia persica* 'Vanessa')/ Emerald sunshine elm (*Ulmus propinqua* 'JFS-Bieberich') (3)
-  Shumard oak (*Quercus shumardii*)/ Nuttall oak (*Quercus nuttallii*)/ Fern pine (*Afrocarpus gracilior*) (1)
-  Wireless zelkova (*Zelkova serrata* 'Schmidtlow')/ Hedge maple (*Acer campestre*)/ Trident maple (*Acer buergerianum*) (7)
-  Emerald sunshine elm (*Ulmus propinqua* 'JFS-Bieberich')/ Hedge maple (*Acer campestre*) (2)- smaller canopy than maple to avoid shading solar panels
-  October Glory red maple (*Acer rubrum* 'October Glory') (4)
-  Freeman maple (*Acer x freemanii* 'Jeffersred')/ Green Mountain silver linden (*Tilia tomentosa* 'PNI 6051') (4)
-  Fern pine (*Afrocarpus gracilior*)/ Arizona cypress (*Hesperocyparis arizonica*) (3)- evergreen for winter shade
-  Black tupelo (*Nyssa sylvatica* 'Haymanred')/ Red horsechestnut (*Aesculus x carnea* 'Briotii') (2)
