What began as a small food pantry has grown into a comprehensive network of programs providing more than **3 million meals** through our client-choice grocery store, home deliveries, food rescue partnerships, and our Food for Kids weekend meal program.

The Vision

As we enter our 25th year, we are launching The Legacy Campaign: Feeding Tomorrow, Today to establish a permanent and sustainable home for Community Storehouse. Owning our facility will strengthen our financial foundation, reduce monthly operating costs, and protect our mission from the uncertainty of rent increases or relocations.

This is about more than a building. It is about ensuring that every dollar entrusted to us goes further toward feeding neighbors, supporting families, and transforming lives.

The Opportunity

Community Storehouse currently operates all its programs under one roof. We have learned firsthand how much efficiency, collaboration, and community connection come from working together in one central location.

However, leasing a large facility has created high ongoing expenses that strain resources needed for our mission. We are now pursuing the purchase of a property that will allow us to downsize and stabilize our operations while maintaining the same programs and services our community depends on.

Owning our own space will enable us to:

- Eliminate rent costs
- Cut utility expenses through improved efficiency and right-sized space
- Redirect monthly savings toward food programs and direct services
- Invest in long-term stability and protect our mission for the next generation

The Goal: \$500,000

We are seeking to raise \$500,000 to secure and prepare a permanent home for Community Storehouse.

Funds will support:

- Property acquisition and site preparation
- Necessary renovations and accessibility improvements
- Program equipment and infrastructure needs
- Campaign and transition expenses
