


We provide short-term services and solutions for able-bodied adults, and long-term services for disabled and elderly individuals.

Every year in the U.S. nearly 100 billion pounds of food available for human consumption is thrown away.


To prevent this massive waste and to feed people in need, food banks and charities across the country have implemented food rescue programs that deliver prepared and soon-to-be expired food directly to nonprofits with feeding programs.

Through the program Community Storehouse collects food from grocers, restaurants, convenience stores, and vendors who have excess perishable food and distribute the food to individuals and families in need, locally in Martinsville and Henry County.









Our Food for Kids: School Backpack Program makes a difference in the lives of at risk children by providing individually packaged, easily prepared meals to utilize during weekends away from other resources - such as free breakfast and lunch programs at school - to children identified by their teacher or school counselor, delivered directly to local schools.





Those who struggle with mobility and/or transportation qualify for our delivery program, we have the capacity to provide up to 2,000 deliveries per week! This element eliminates a huge service gap for many individuals in our community!

Our retail store is the cornerstone of fundraising, meant to further our mission. We were temporarily closed to relocate our 30,000 square feet of equipment to our new location, while continuing essential services uninterrupted.
