Quality is the key to successful sales. Items that are clean, complete, and in great condition are far more likely to sell quickly and for a good price. Please take the time to prepare your items thoughtfully to ensure the best results.

- Clothing: Inspect items under good lighting to spot and address stains or markings.
- Toys: Ensure all pieces are included. Place small parts in a Ziploc bag and securely attach it to the item using wire ties (preferred over tape).
- Large Toys & Baby Equipment: Wash all fabric components to ensure cleanliness. Wipe down surfaces for a fresh appearance to increase chances of sale.
- Books: Check for ripped pages or excessive writing (names on the inside cover are acceptable).
- Puzzles: Store pieces in a Ziploc bag or wrap securely with saran wrap and tape. Avoid taping tags directly onto puzzle images or boxes to prevent damage.
- Accepted Items: Refer to the "What We Accept" list to confirm items meet requirements (e.g., some must be new).
- Pricing: The minimum price is \$1.00 for books and \$2.50 for all other items. Make sure your items meet the value of the minimum price.
- Create a donation bin during item gathering for low-value or unsellable items. Avoid wasting time tagging items that won't sell.

Quality Issue Fees: Items failing quality checks can incur fees deducted from consignor sales.
