individuals transitioned from temporary to permanent residents.

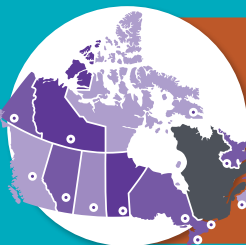
