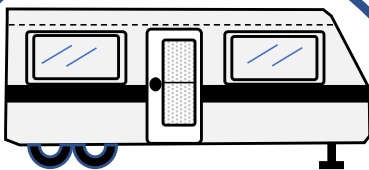
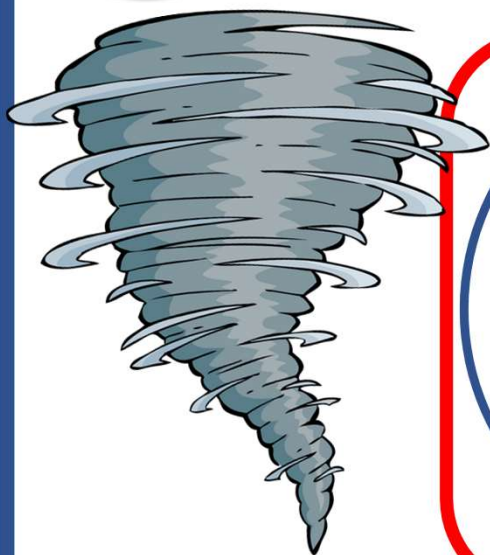

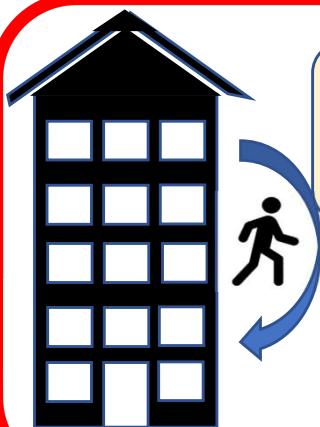
Hoja informativa: tornados

Las casas móviles no son seguras en un tornado. Salga mientras sea posible.



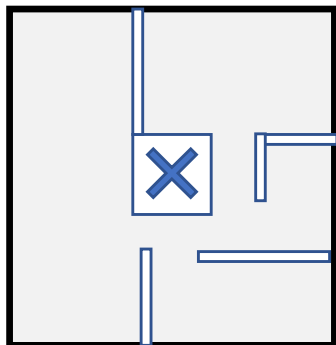
Si habita en un edificio, hable con sus vecinos y establezcan un plan de emergencia juntos.

Si está en un edificio, o casa de más de un nivel, muévase hacia el nivel más bajo posible.

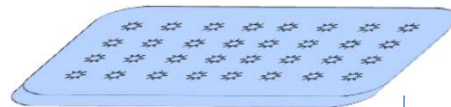
Al refugiarse

Use ropa de pantalón largo y manga larga, zapatos fuertes, y casco si es posible.

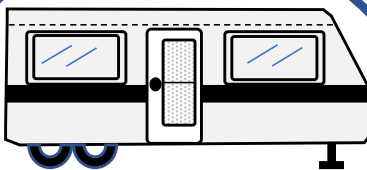
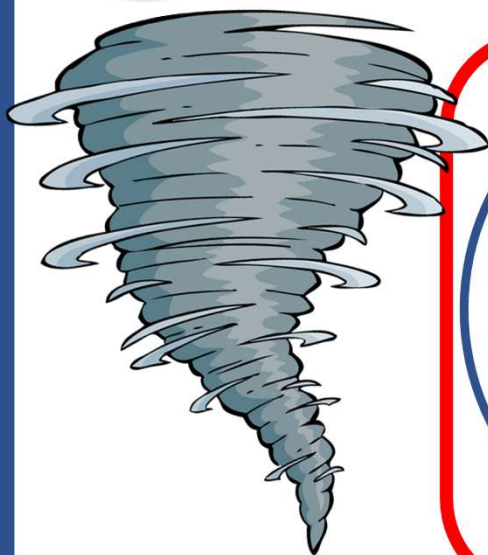


Agáchese hasta el suelo, cúbrase la cabeza con las manos, busque protección debajo de un colchón o manta.

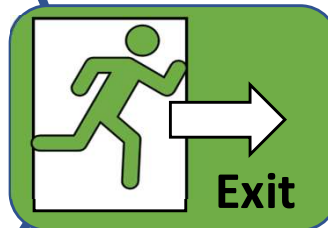

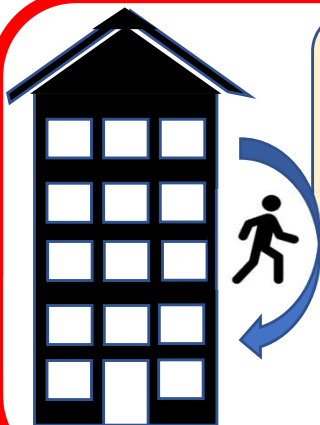
Informative flyer: tornados



If you live in a mobile home or trailer, plan ahead and identify where would you go for shelter in case of a tornado.



Mobile homes and trailers are not safe during tornados. Exit while it is still safe to do so.

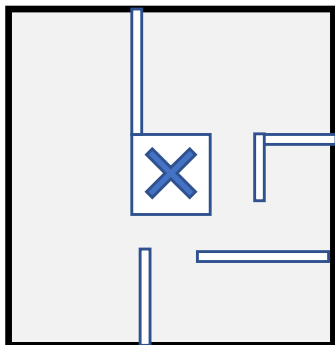


If you live (or work) in a building, talk to your neighbors and establish an emergency plan together ahead of time.



During a tornado
If you are in a building, or in a multiple level home, move to the lowest level possible.

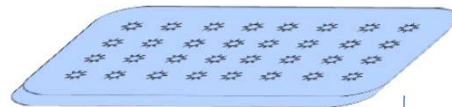
SHELTERING



Look for a small room without windows, like a closet or bathroom, with the most walls between you and the outside of the house.



Use long pants, long sleeve shirts, strong shoes and a helmet if possible.



Get close to the ground, cover your head with your hands, and seek shelter under a mattress or blankets.
