

## Rules of the Event

1. The event is not a race; safety comes first.
  2. Anyone can enter but must visit each checkpoint via water vessel.
  3. Each hand is \$10
  4. Participants may purchase up to 5 hands.
  5. Participants register for the event and receive a scorecard for each hand purchased.
  6. There are 7 total checkpoints that must be visited. Participants must visit every checkpoint and collect a card to qualify.
  7. At each checkpoint, participants draw a card, which is marked on their scorecard.
  8. The run ends at the final location where scorecards are submitted.
  9. The participants' **best** 5 cards of the 7 are used for scoring.
  10. The best poker hand at the end of the event wins.
- **Royal Flush:** A, K, Q, J, 10, all in the same suit.
  - **Straight Flush:** Five cards in a sequence, all in the same suit.
  - **Four of a Kind:** All four cards of the same rank.
  - **Full House:** Three of a kind with a pair.
  - **Flush:** Any five cards of the same suit, but not in a sequence.
  - **Straight:** Five cards in a sequence, but not of the same suit.
  - **Three of a Kind:** Three cards of the same rank.
  - **Two Pair:** Two different pairs.
  - **Pair:** Two cards of the same rank.

In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined using suits. Clubs rank lowest, followed by diamonds, hearts, and spades.
