PXT 200 Series:

PXT 201 Day one of our most popular 8 hour courses which include a short classroom session followed by an all hands on introduction to modern auto extrication practices using hydraulic and non hydraulic rescue tools.

PXT 202 Day two of our Advanced Auto Extrication is an all hands on course utilizing air bags, hydraulic, pneumatic and hand tools. The focus is on advanced stabilization & lifting to free entrapped victims in simulated accident scenarios.

PXT400 Lecture (Heavy Vehicle) Day three is on incidents involving heavy vehicles, including the types of extrication scenarios encountered and how vehicle design and construction affect operations. Learn to perform various techniques on heavy vehicles that may include semitrailers and larger vehicles, including rescue from side underrides, rollovers, and rear underrides. Students are introduced to rotating wreckers. Topics include advanced stabilization, street-smart cribbing, heavy truck extrication, underrides, tunneling, and wrecker-assist extrication

EQUIPMENT:

The tools utilized in this course are new technology and represent current rescue equipment available from fire/rescue equipment vendors. These include spreaders and cutters, airbags, struts, air chisels, hand tools, cribbing, and much more.

PPE - TURN OUT GEAR:

Firefighters must be equipped with appropriate PPE that meets WAC 296-305-02001, Personal Protective Equipment and Protective Clothing, Extrication PPE (Department approved) may be appropriate for some scenarios.

TOPICS COVERED INCLUDE:

- NFPA Standards; 1001, 1006 & 1670.
- Incident Command, Scene Control, & Responder Safety.
- Auto extrication, with and without hydraulic rescue tools.
- Shoring, Airbags, & Stabilization.
- Mitigating Hazardous Conditions
