

### REASONS TO INTERVENE

1. Directly affected property owner. Gore-Doubs-Goose Creek and/or Valley Link will cross my property and/or result in the taking of my property by eminent domain.
2. Proximally affected property owner. Gore-Doubs-Goose Creek and/or Valley Link will be located within (distance) of my property. Gore-Doubs-Goose Creek and/or Valley Link will lower the value of my property and/or expose me to harmful EMF radiation.
3. Affected ratepayer. The cost of Gore-Doubs-Goose Creek and/or Valley Link will increase my electric bill while I will receive no direct benefit. All the benefits from this project are for data centers in Virginia.
4. Parent of child at South Jefferson Elementary School (or staff member). Gore-Doubs-Goose Creek and/or Valley Link will more than double the amount of high-voltage transmission approximately 500 feet from the elementary school my child attends. Studies have shown a statistical link between EMF and childhood leukemia. I object to this unnecessary risk to my child's health and well being.
5. Gore-Doubs-Goose Creek and/or Valley Link's visibility will detrimentally affect the value of my property.
6. Gore-Doubs-Goose Creek and/or Valley Link's devaluation of real property in Jefferson County will result in a marked decrease in the County's tax base, requiring tax rates to increase for all property owners in the County.

Your legal interest in the case should be unique, although many will intervene with similar reasons. Every property impacted by the transmission line(s) has a unique interest that cannot be represented by another property owner.
