Supply List

(note: you do not have to bring everything on the first few days of class)

- six binders for Philosophy and Management, Math, Language appendix, Biology and Physical Science, Geography, and History albums (2" or 3" spines – higher-quality binders work best). Note – some people like 4" binders, but I find them awkward and heavy when filled – approx. \$78
- page protectors for albums (about \$12/200 at Costco) – optional – approx. \$30
- stick-on divider tabs – approx. \$10
- plain paper (e.g., printer paper) – approx. \$3
- notebook paper – approx. \$3
- graph paper (approx. ¼" grid) – optional (may be useful for certain illustrations)
- high-quality colored pencils (e.g., Prismacolor, 24-color set works well – look for a coupon from Michael's to buy them at a discount) - approx. \$20
- pens, pencils, eraser, pencil sharpener
- ruler
- scissors
- stapler
- paper punch
- glue stick
- Sharpie marker, highlighter
- sticky notes – optional, but handy
- camera – optional – for photos of materials during lessons

Optional items for your comfort:

- pillow
- snacks – many groups schedule and share these as a community
- water
- sweater
- rolling luggage holder or rolling bin to transport albums
