Horses and/or Ponies will be shown at a Walk, Trot, Halt and Canter in both directions. At the Judge's discretion they may be asked to show a lengthening or collection of stride, to halt.

Class 279:

Hunter Showmanship:

Horses and/or Ponies will be shown at a Walk, Trot, and Canter in both directions. At the Judge's discretion they may be asked to show a lengthening or collection of stride and to Halt. From the Lineup, each participant will be asked to individually go out and trot or canter over two cross rail obstacles no higher than 18", Halt, Back Three Steps, and return to the Lineup. **Class 280:** Hunter Showmanship

Judged Warm Up Hunter/Equitation Classes

Open to all Riders. Ribbons will be awarded to all rounds that the Judge rates with a score of 75 or above. Fence Heights will move with divisions. You may enter this class as many times as you want.
