CASE HISTORY

Enviroklean Stain Remover CarWell CP90

Problem

The October 15, 2006 Big Island earthquake caused the entire south end of the Mauna Kea Resort to collapse, and destroyed the hotel's top floor. The hotel closed December 1, 2006 after a month-long inspection revealed that the building was unsafe and in danger of collapse. After a \$150 million renovation, the hotel reopened in December, 2008.* As part of the renovations, Mauna Kea Resort installed stainless steel cable pickets in existing railings to bring railings up to current building code.

These Stainless Steel Cable pickets were rusting and unsightly. Left unprotected—pitting and corrosion would eat into the cables and would reduce the life and effectiveness of these pickets.

Solution and Procedure

- 1. Apply Enviroklean Stain Remover by brush or sponge
- 2. Rinse with fresh water.
- 3. Apply CarWell CP90 to all exposed metal surfaces.

Conclusion

Use of Enviroklean Stain Remover easily removed the rust staining on the Stainless Steel Cable Pickets and applying CarWell CP90/Rust Cop rust inhibitor will provide further corrosion protection. Follow up maintenance required on yearly basis.
