Q? How much Salt-Away would it take to rinse down 10,000 sq ft house? Have customer who does maintenance for a house right on the beach and he liked the idea of SALT-AWAY for maintenance possibly on weekly or monthly schedule. Any suggestions? Would he have to wet house first or just hook up SAM to garden hose and go for it?

It would take about 40 ounces, but realistically, I would allow 1/2 gallon (64 ounces). Using the SAM, he would need to fill it 10 times, so for that job, I would get a bigger dispenser. If he can find a garden fertilizer unit where the setting can be dialed, he should use that. The dial setting should be the lowest measure of product to the greatest amount of water. I think there are some that has a setting of 1 teaspoon. He would not have to wet the house first, just go for it.

I learned something from that lady customer of yours that wants to start a business of cleaning windows with Salt-Away. Since she lives in a house on a cliff facing the ocean, her windows get really foggy with salt. She said that after cleaning her windows with other methods, they need it again in 3 days. She said after cleaning it with Salt-Away, they stay clear for a month.

That just boggles my mind! I didn't know SA did that. So he should set the maintenance program schedule after he sees the results. If he wants a bigger paycheck, maybe every 2 weeks. (I'd hate to do it weekly!)
