- Salt-Away is the perfect product to remove salt from your boat trailers and towing vehicles.
- Depending on the equipment, some boaters expose their towing vehicle to salt water while launching their boats, and forget to remove the salt from the undercarriage of the vehicle.
- [Using Salt-Away's Kit](#) it is easy to remove the salt from the undercarriage of your vehicle.

- For removing salt from your trailer, you can get the best results by spraying the trailer with Salt-Away immediately after launching your boat, and again after loading the boat back onto the trailer. The best equipment to use for this job is a compression pump sprayer (weed sprayer). Add 2 fluid ounces of Salt-Away (59 ml) to each US gallon (3.79L) of water in the tank.
- Use [Salt-Away's Kit](#), the ideal product for flushing the salt through your trailer's brake flushing system.
- Some trailer manufacturers build trailers with the capability of flushing the salt from the brakes, using a hose connector and water line going to the brakes.

- Just connect Salt-Away's Mixing Unit in line between the hose and the connector, and flush until you see the foaming action coming out on the ground, then turn the Unit off.
- Salt-Away will not harm your brake pads, or any part of the braking system.
- Leave Salt-Away inside the braking system to inhibit rusting and other corrosion.
