



Colorado River Women's Council Boombox Parade

- ◆ Boombox entries must be pre-registered.
- ◆ Parade check-in is at the driveway on Langford in front of the Epcor Water Co. A CRWC Rep will direct you where to line up. The line up is on a first come first serve basis. All of the other driveways will be closed and no one is to park in this parking lot other than parade floats.
- ◆ Entries will start lining up at 3:00pm. Any entries lining up before 3:00pm. will be disqualified.
- ◆ **DO NOT LEAVE ANY VEHICLES UNATTENDED WHILE IN THE STAGING AREA**
- ◆ All float participants are required to check-in by 5:00pm. (AZ Time). Failure to do this will result in not being judged for awards.
- ◆ The parade will start promptly at 6pm. Parade route will be handed out when you check-in.
- ◆ The official parade float judging station will be located in front of the Mohave County Supervisors Office. Judges will be judging from the south side of the parade route.
- ◆ All entries **MUST** have a boombox and **tuned to 104.9 KISS FM ONLY**
- ◆ **NO THROWING CANDY, must be hand passed out only!**
- ◆ **NO PASSING OUT FLYERS OR LITERATURE. No solicitations of any kind IN THE STAGING AREA OR DURING THE PARADE.**
- ◆ **DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO WALK AROUND THE STAGING AREA OR IN THE PARADE. DOGS MUST HAVE A SECURE FITTING COLLAR/HARNESS AND A FLAT 4-6 FOOT LEASH (NO RETRACTABLE LEASHES) AND REMAIN WITH AN ADULT ON YOUR FLOAT OR IN A VEHICLE.**
- ◆ WALKING GROUPS ENCOURGED. All members must be able to keep up with the parade pace.
- ◆ HORSE ENTRIES are confined to the end of the parade. Owners are responsible for clean-up.
- ◆ ALL ENTRIES are limited to one car and one trailer unless pre-approved by CRWC.
- ◆ CAR CLUBS/GROUPS: Cars must be in good running condition and able to idle while stopping and starting throughout the parade for up to 3 hours
- ◆ SANTAS: No Santa suits are to be worn.
- ◆ We recommend, if possible, that you house your generators in a box so the Christmas music can be heard.
- ◆ **Please do not ask any business to use their restrooms.** Port-a-potties will be provided at the staging site.
- ◆ NO ALCOHOL is allowed in the staging area or during the parade.
- ◆ **The parade will end on Alonas Way near City Hall. NOWHERE ELSE.**
- ◆ The City will host a "Winter Fest" party immediately after the parade at the Riverview Mall.
- ◆ Bicycle entries are required to wear helmets.
