

Items that can be checked out at the Center for group or individual Service Projects



Call for availability as some of these items may not be available (208-497-2868)

For inquiries about items to be taken from the Center:

1. Sewing Dept: (**individual** volunteers or for **groups** if they provide their own sewing machines and own fabric)
 - a. Hygiene Bags - Patterns are available
 - b. Quilt Tops
 - c. Pillowcases
 - d. Fleece Balls
 - i. **MUST** come into the Center and be taught before checked out.
2. Yarn Dept: (**individual** volunteers)
 - a. Bibs and Burp clothes (crochet)
 - b. Receiving Blankets (crochet)
 - i. Pick up these items to crochet around the edges
 - ii. Crochet Thread is available
 - c. Yarn Kits
 - d. Fidget Toys (**individual** volunteers) (crochet)
 - i. Volunteers can buy their own yarn or pick up a partial skein or ball of yarn at the Center to crochet
 - ii. Instructions:
 1. YouTube: Do a search for “Miranda’s Magic Fidget Crochet pattern”
3. Small Projects: Cutting project only (**Groups** or **individuals**)
 - a. The volunteers must provide their own fleece and flannel
 - b. We provide the patterns for the volunteers to sew
 - i. Fleece Toy Balls
 - ii. Flannel Burrito Baby Blankets
 - c. **MUST** come into the Center and be taught before items are checked out
4. Community Room: (Groups and Individuals)
 - a. Hygiene Kit supplies (see website for details)
 - b. Additional supplies needed now: Shave Cream, Men and women razors, all purpose cleaner, dish soap, bleach, toilet paper, paper towels, diapers (all sizes), laundry detergent
5. Folder Games: (groups and individuals)
 - a. Can only check out 10 folders per **group** (regardless of how many are in the group of volunteers)
 - b. For **individuals** only 5 folders can be checked out
6. Wood toys cannot be checked out – however they can be sanded and painted at the Center

NOTE: We are not allowing quilt kits to be checked out and tied outside of the Center
