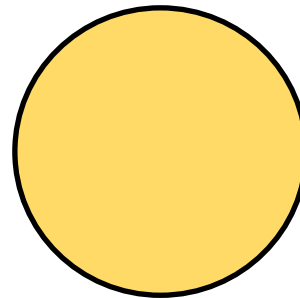

doxologia, meaning

“glorifying” or “praising God,”
often found at the end of a
prayer or hymn.

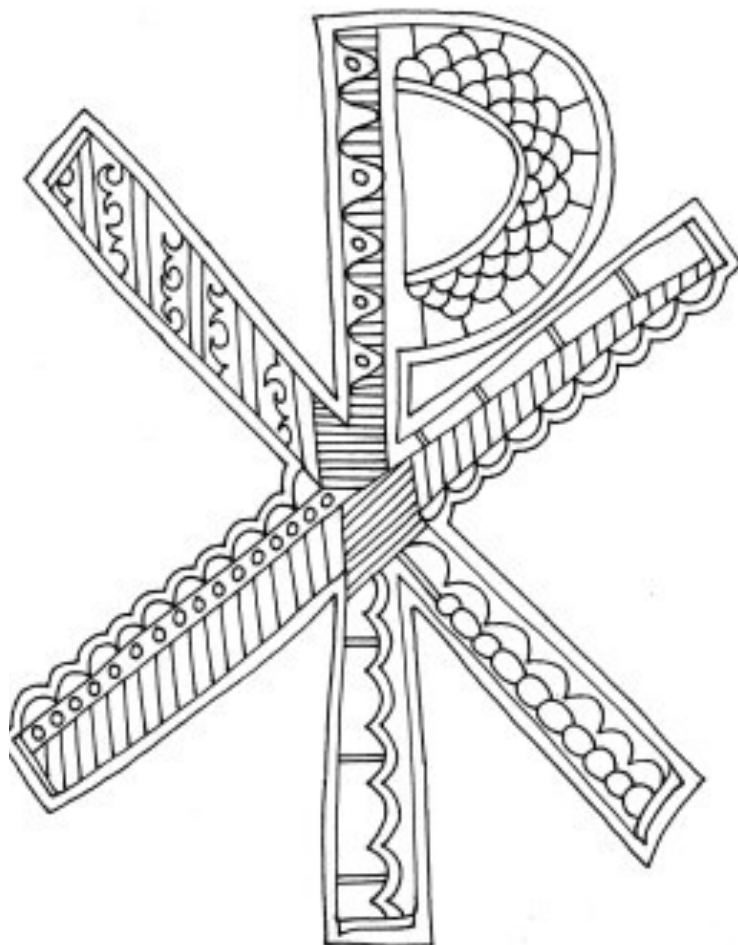
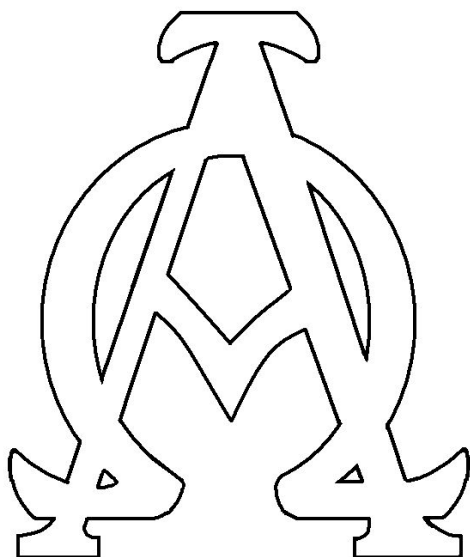

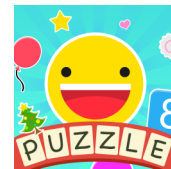
Draw or colour a Christ Monogram

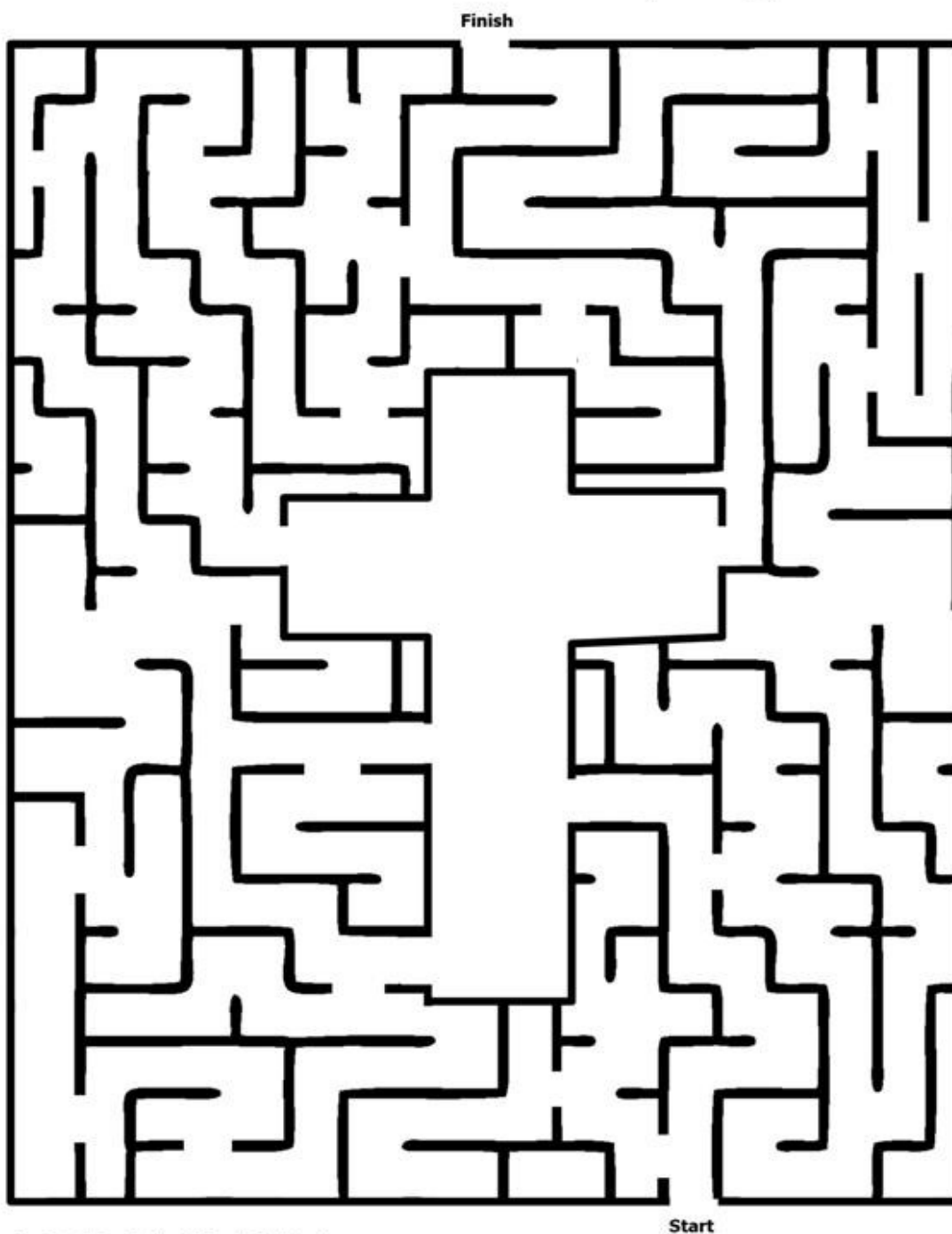
Or draw and colour the Alpha and Omega sign—God is with us forever the beginning and end



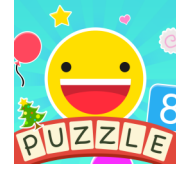

Green reminds us of the world



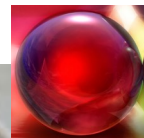
Rainbow beads remind us of God's promises
