Reflect— on how are we doing and feeling? Circle the emoji that you feel like! Or draw a new emoji or several as we may have mixed emotions and feelings.















Palm Sunday—5th April 2020



Play a game of pin the tale on the donkey—This introduces the story of palm Sunday



Story time—Read the palm story page 361 story 318 in the children's bible in 365 stories or mark 11 (see the next page)

Think or imagine how dark it was when you play pin the tale on the donkey. It's difficult when you can't see things, everything is much harder when we can't see what we are doing. Life is difficult and hard when we don't see and know Jesus in our lives. Jesus led the way in the palm Sunday story and the people followed.

Close your eyes—Think about how Jesus sat on the donkey with the people waving and singing in the street with so much joy, singing Hosanna, save us. It is only Jesus that could save and help the people and bring the people Joy. Jesus can still bring joy to us today, save us Lord Jesus we ask.

Think about the things in our lives that we would like Jesus to lead us in and help us with. He is the rescuer and Lord.

The Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem Mark 11 –1-11

Other references to the story are (Matthew 21.1-11; Luke 19.28-40; John 12.12-19)

1As they approached Jerusalem, near the towns of Bethphage and Bethany, they came to the Mount of Olives. Jesus sent two of his disciples on ahead 2 with these instructions: "Go to the village there ahead of you. As soon as you get there, you will find a colt tied up that has never been ridden. Untie it and bring it here. 3And if someone asks you why you are doing that, say that the Master needs it and will send it back at once."

4So they went and found a colt out in the street, tied to the door of a house. As they were untying it, 5some of the bystanders asked them, "What are you doing, untying that colt?"

6. They answered just as Jesus had told them, and the crowd let them go. 7They brought the colt to Jesus, threw their cloaks over the animal, and Jesus got on. 8Many people spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches in the field and spread them on the road. 9 The people who were in front and those who followed behind began to shout, "Praise God! God bless him who comes in the name of the Lord! 10God bless the coming kingdom of King David,

- 1) How did the disciples, the Jesus best friends follow the instructions— would you have followed the instructions?
- 2) How do you think they felt?
- 3) How did the people welcome Jesus? How were they feeling?
- 4) How does the story make you feel about Jesus?
- 5) The word hosanna means –means saviour, save or rescue—how do we need to be helped or rescued in our lives?

Make palms to wave and palm crosses, follow the instructions on the video on the ink or on the instructions on the next page












Play songs as you draw around your hands on different coloured card, cut out and assemble together.


