




This activity works well with young children. Have a bowl of water & a towel ready to wash afterwards, this makes a nice keepsake for grandparents. **What can you make with your foot print?**

Play with sand in a sand tray, sand pit or think about a visit you had to the beach—leave a good footprint

How does the sand feel?

Add water to the sand slowly and walk in the sand or press your foot in the sand —how does it feel?

Look at your foot prints—can someone follow in them—think about how we can follow Jesus.

Look at the foot prints where do you think they are going?

Where are the feet going ? Think, Can you leave a trace of where you have been by your kind acts.




Fidget Spinner—Prayers & Fun!!

Decorate each letter of the word GOD, using illustrations.


on the **G** draw or write descriptions of the Father,

Decorate a pebble with the fruit of the Spirit. Love, Joy, Peace, kindness, self-control, gentleness, patience, goodness & faithfulness




Which fruits of the Spirit would you like? Ask God for them.



Think about where to Go and who is special , who could you share Good news with – Stay safe !



Can you share Good news with your family, parents, family or friends




Design your Go Sign—put on a door or hang somewhere as a reminder

Pray for the world—colour, draw or write names of family & friends on the globe.



You will need a template, scissors and glue




Instructions to build a world

1. Print out the template
2. Cut out the template.
(no pink left)
3. Fold the tabs with the numbers on.
4. Glue a tab, one at a time folding & sticking starting at 1. and so on until all tabs are stuck down.
5. Hold the world in your hand look at the countries to see what you recognise.
6. Pray for the world.
7. Think about how you can look after the world.
8. Who can you share this with. Enjoy.




