Fishable Water

- Lake Mitchell & Tributaries
- Lake Jordan & Tributaries
- Tailwaters & Tributaries

One Fly

Each participant is allowed one fly pattern of their choice, in one color & one size. Multiple flies of that combination are allowed. We all know you'll lose them to trees & rocks...

The fly must be visible in the photos submitted via the Fishing Chaos app. The fly shown in your first photo submission is your one fly, anything else will not be counted.

Scoring

- The tournament will be hosted on the Fishing Chaos app. The code to join the tournament will be given at the captain's meeting the day before.
- Highest total number of redeye (*Micropterus coosae*) & spotted bass (*Micropterus henshalli*) caught will win. There will be 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place prizes.
- This is in an effort to reduce fish handling time, please refrain from weighing & measuring fish and follow Keep Fish Wet guidelines.
 - Each participant will submit a photo of each fish to the Fishing Chaos tournament platform with the code from the captain's meeting visible.

Lines in at 7:00am CST.

Lines out at 2:00pm CST.

No motors.

This is a solo fishing tournament, however we encourage you to wade or float and compete with a buddy.
