One Fly

Each participant is allowed one fly pattern of their choice, in one color & one size. Multiple flies of that combination are allowed. We know you'll lose them to trees & rocks...

The fly must be visible in the photos submitted via the Fishing Chaos app. The fly shown in your first photo submission is your one fly, anything else will not be counted.

Scoring

- Each participant will submit a photo of each fish to the Fishing Chaos tournament platform with a code from the captain's meeting visible.
- Highest total number of redeye (Micropterus coosae) & spotted bass (Micropterus henshalli) caught will win. There will be 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place prizes.
- In an effort to reduce fish handling time, please refrain from weighing & measuring fish and follow <u>Keep Fish Wet</u> guidelines.
- -Photo submissions must have location permissions turned on. This ensures catches were made within the boundaries. Learn where to test this in the app, and how to change any necessary settings here.

No motors.

This is a solo fishing tournament, however we encourage you to wade or float and compete with a buddy.
