Adults' Emergency

You can access the Adults' Emergency Department from Aylestone Road. There is a 20 minute drop-off zone outside the main entrance, or you can use the multi-storey car park on Havelock Street.

Children's Emergency

The Children's Emergency Department entrance is completely separate and can be found on Infirmary Square. There is a 20 minute drop-off zone outside the main entrance, or you can use the short stay car park between the Balmoral, Jarvis and Kensington Buildings. Please follow the signs.

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation.
- Is there a risk of further injury?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the qualified First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.

In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services – 999.

- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- Contact the injured person's parent / carer / guardian.
- Complete an Incident / Accident Report Form.
