Two Eras of Ohio History in One Day Trip

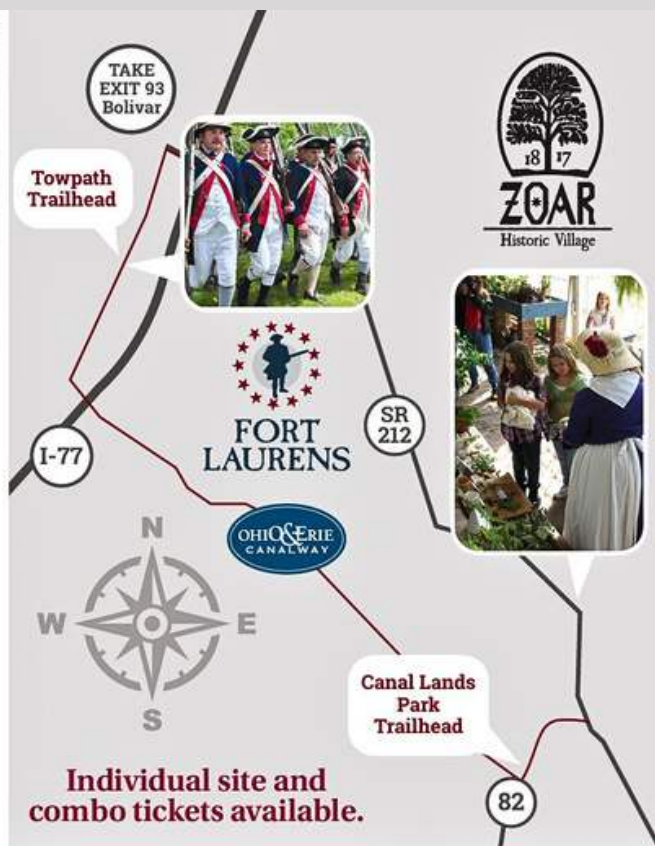

PRESERVING THE PAST

Where History and Heritage Shape the County's Story

Tuscarawas County is a treasure trove of American history, offering visitors a chance to step back in time and explore the rich past of this Ohio region. With its vital role in the development of the railroads, Tuscarawas County has played a significant part in shaping the nation's growth. One of the county's most notable historic sites is the **Dennison Railroad Depot Museum**, a National Historic Landmark that once served as a major hub during World War II. The depot tells the fascinating story of how it supported the war effort, The **Age of Steam Roundhouse**, with its fully operational 18-stall brick roundhouse and a 115-foot turntable, stands as a masterpiece of traditional railroad architecture and houses an impressive collection of restored steam locomotives.

For those interested in frontier life, Tuscarawas County is home to key historic sites. **Fort Laurens**, the only Revolutionary War fort in Ohio, offers a glimpse into the nation's early years. Nearby, the site of the **Gnadenhutten Massacre** memorializes the tragic 1782 event, when 96 peaceful Christian Native Americans were massacred. Another must-visit is **Historic Schoenbrunn Village**, Ohio's first official settlement, where visitors can explore 18th-century cabins and other buildings showcasing the region's Moravian heritage. These sites will offer you a deeper understanding of Tuscarawas County's history.

The heart of Tuscarawas culture

Tuscarawas County is a treasure trove for art and culture enthusiasts. From vibrant murals that tell the region's rich stories to live performances that captivate audiences, the arts are an essential part of the county's identity. Whether you're exploring outdoor installations, attending a theater production, or discovering local history through art, there's something for everyone to enjoy.



Murals: Art That Tells a Story

Murals across Tuscarawas County transform everyday spaces into vibrant reflections of the community's history and culture.

In **Newcomerstown**, their murals honor the town's heritage, including the baseball legend Cy Young, celebrating its pride and history.

Dennison pays tribute to its World War II role as "Dreamsville USA," with many murals depicting the camaraderie and service of its historic canteen.

Meanwhile, in **Sugarcreek**, the "Little Switzerland of Ohio," enchants visitors with Alpine-themed murals showcasing beautiful Swiss-inspired landscapes and traditions, creating a storybook-like charm.

Inspiring Community Spirit

Other notable murals throughout the county celebrate everything from canal history to agricultural traditions, turning your stroll into an artistic adventure. These public artworks not only beautify their surroundings but also invite residents and visitors alike to pause, reflect, and appreciate the vibrant creativity of the region. Each mural tells a story, weaving together the community's past, present, and future in vivid color.



Performing Arts Center (PAC)

LoveTusc Sculpture Tour

Adding another layer to the county's creative landscape is the fun **LoveTusc Sculpture Tour**, an inspiring collection of 18 sculptures spread across the entire county. These works blend styles, and themes to reflect the unique message of each area and local artists while drawing inspiration from Tuscarawas County's one-of-a-kind charm.



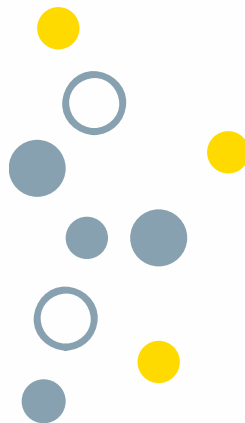

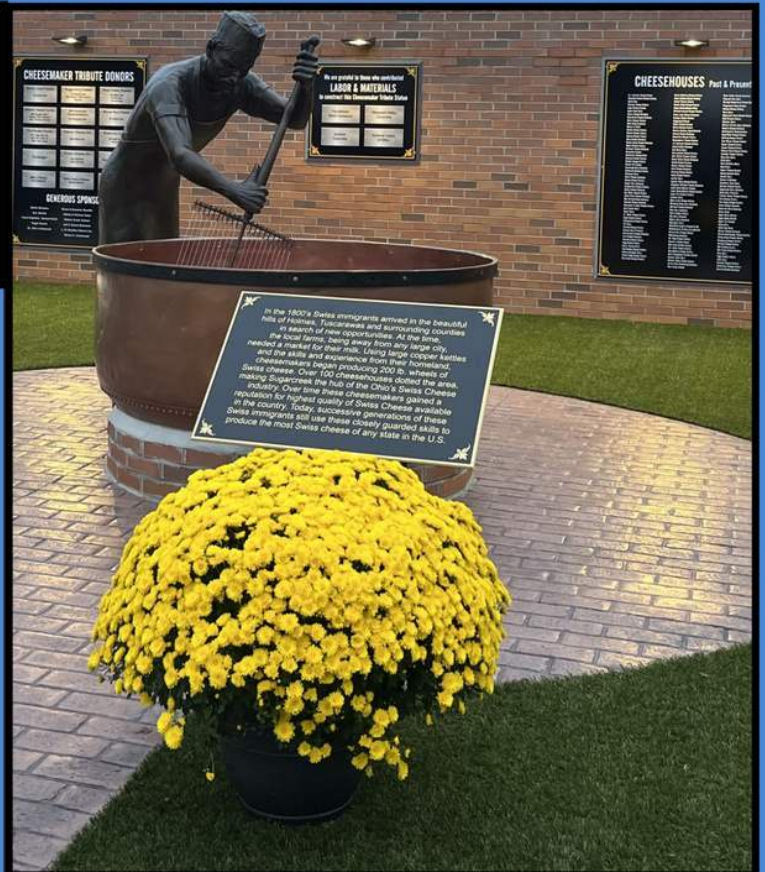
