# Schoenbrunn 250th

HISTORIC SCHOENBRUNN VILLAGE \* FOUNDED IN 1772



The Declaration of Independence would not be signed for another four years when Moravian Missionary David Zeisberger and five families of Christian Delaware Indians, also known as Lenape, arrived in the Tuscarawas Valley. Zeisberger, having been invited to establish a mission by Delaware Indian leader Netawatwes, founded Schoenbrunn, meaning Beautiful Spring on May 3, 1772.

history of the families who lived in each one is known. In the 5-year period the mission thrived at Schoenbrunn, the group built the first church and school in what was then known as the Ohio Territory.

Zeisberger accomplished some of his most important work at Schoenbrunn Village. He was the first to record the Delaware language in writing. He wrote a spelling book for children with lists of words in both Delaware and English that is still in use today. He

translated hymns and passages of the Bible into the Delaware language.



The peaceful group of missionaries and Christian Delaware Indians sought to stay neutral even in the face of the brewing American Revolutionary War. They sought to find a place to live in an organized Christian society---a society that valued the contributions of men and women equally and made education the focus for all children. In the schoolhouse, boys and girls used separate doors to enter the building where they were seated on opposite sides of the room, but their education was the same.

Due to the meticulous records kept by Zeisberger and later archaeological surveys, all the rebuilt structures have been placed in the exact spot they were 250 years ago and the names and

Now, nearly 250 years to the day when Zeisberger and his congregation set foot in Schoenbrunn, visitors will have the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to join in a semi quincennial celebration at the reconstructed village on the very soil that Zeisberger and the Christian Delaware once walked and worked. May 3, 2022 we will kick off the 250th Schoenbrunn Village Anniversary Celebration which will continue for an entire year.

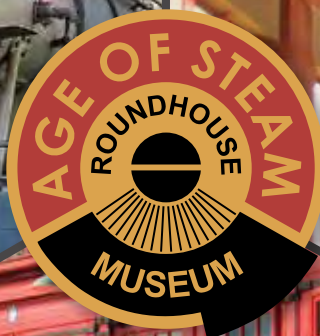

## Second Village of Gnadenhutzen Established

Schoenbrunn grew quickly and a second Moravian mission, Gnadenhutzen, meaning Tents of Grace, was established in the fall of 1772. At Gnadenhutzen, life for the inhabitants was much the same as at Schoenbrunn. Unfortunately, under pressure from both sides in the Revolution, the inhabitants of Schoenbrunn decided for their own safety to leave the area in 1777.

After the move, all was not quiet in the area. American troops from Fort Pitt made the Tuscarawas Valley a stopping point as they waited to attack the British at Detroit. They finished a fort, Fort Laurens, in December 1778 near the site of present-day Bolivar.



### FORT LAURENS BUILT

Conditions at Fort Laurens, named for Henry Laurens, president of the Continental Congress, were poor. Most of the men returned to Fort Pitt, leaving Fort Laurens woefully undermanned and open to attack by the British and their American Indian sympathizers.

In less than a year, thirty men lost their lives with twenty-one interred in the fort cemetery and the fort was abandoned. Today, the Fort Laurens Museum tells the story of this ill-fated fort and the trials the men endured. It is also an entry point for the Ohio-Erie Canalway Trail, a tranquil path which follows landmarks from another historical era.

## Two and a Half Centuries in the Tuscarawas Valley

# 250th

While Fort Laurens had been the biggest disaster so far in the county, an even darker day was to come on March 8, 1782.

After Gnadenhutzen residents were forced to leave the area in 1781, they returned to search for food. A militia from Pennsylvania arrived and mistook the Christian Indians for ones who had been conducting raids on white settlers. More than 90 innocents were brutally murdered including men, women and children.

At present day Gnadenhutzen, a memorial museum and park is maintained. At the mound, where the remains of the Christian Indians were interred, a Day of Remembrance is held each year (this year on March 8) with members of the Delaware tribe and the community in attendance



### OUTDOOR DRAMA TELLS THE STORY

As the sun sets, visitors are drawn back in time at the outdoor drama, *Trumpet in the Land*, which offers live performances each summer and tells the story of Zeisberger's work at Schoenbrunn, the Gnadenhutzen Massacre and the building of Fort Laurens.

The lure of the Tuscarawas Valley was so great that David Zeisberger returned to the area to found his last mission, Goshen, in 1778. Zeisberger is buried along with others from Goshen in the mission cemetery, men and boys on one side, women and girls on the other.

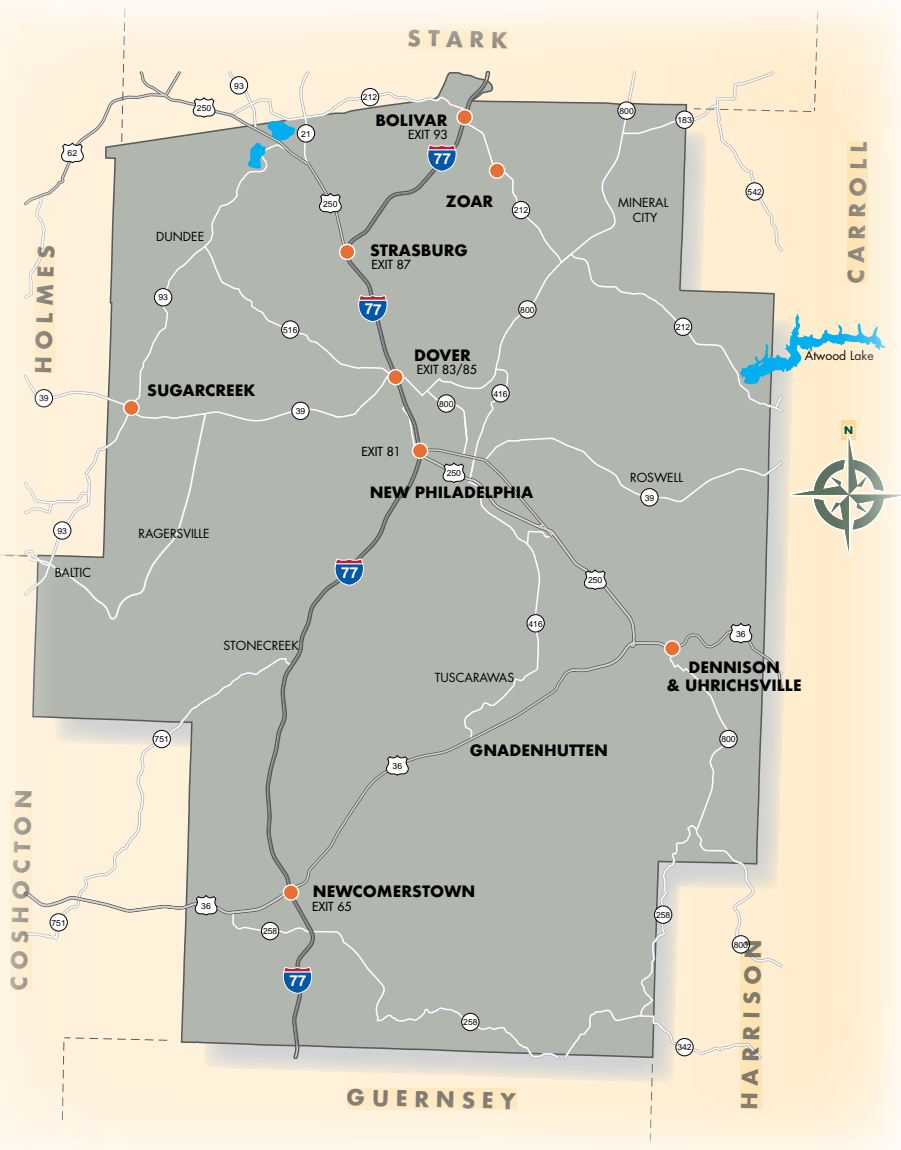

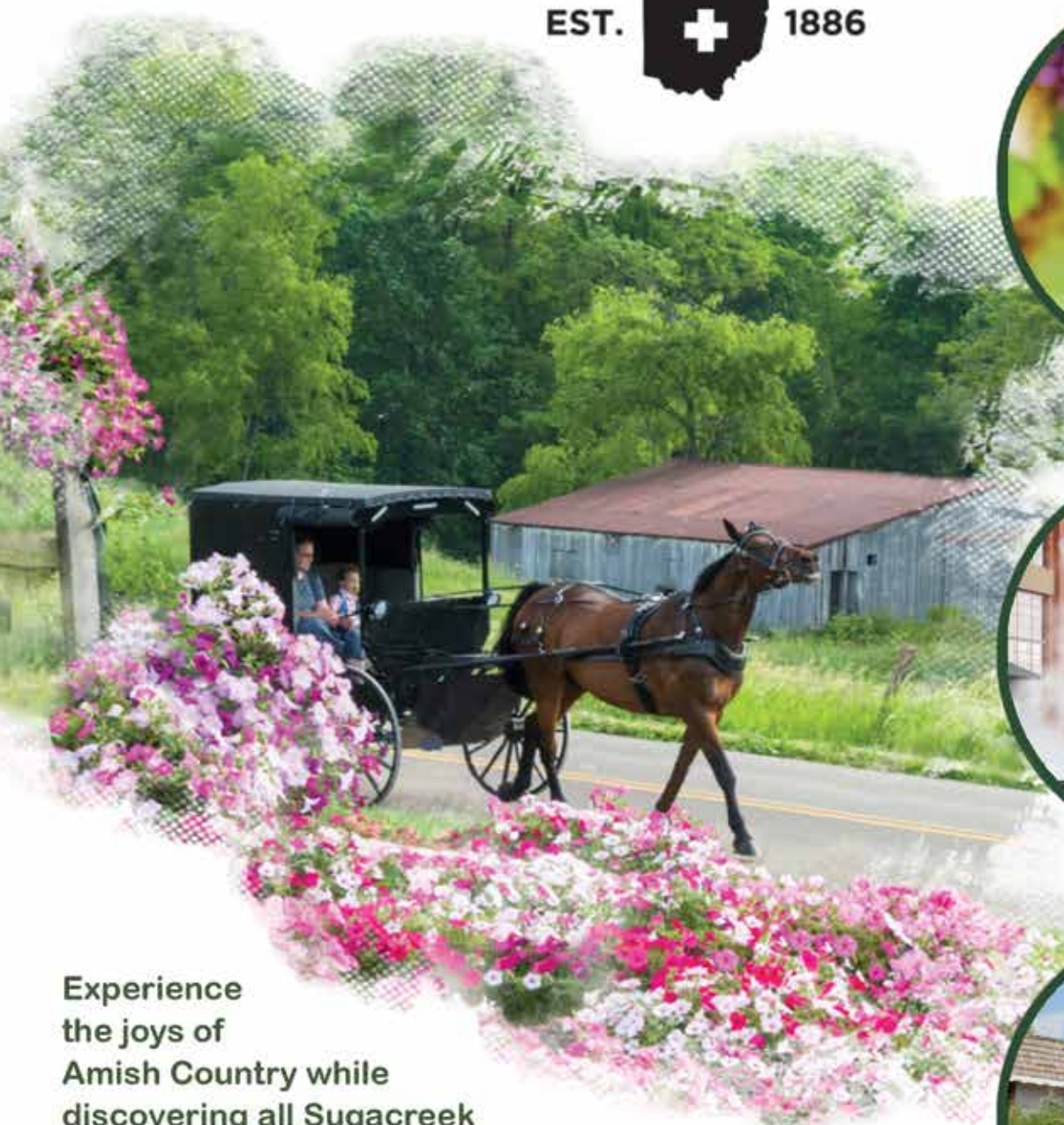
