## Cutting

## Fabrics $\mathbf{A}$ and $B$, cut from each:

(1) $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $15.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) strip; sub-cut (16) Piece 2

## Fabrics C and D, cut from each:

(5) 6" $\times$ WOF ( $15.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(4) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}(15.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 42.86 \mathrm{~cm})$, (4) $6^{\prime \prime}$
$\times 11^{3 / 8 "}(15.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 28.89 \mathrm{~cm})$, and (4) $6^{\prime \prime}$
$(15.24 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

## Fabric E, cut:

(1) $51 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $13.02 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(8) $5^{1 / 8 "}$ " $(13.02 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.

## Fabrics $F$ and $G$, fussy-cut from each:

(6) $6^{\prime \prime}(15.24 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares, ( 2 ) of each animal

## Fabrics I and H , cut from each:

(2) $61 / 4 " \times$ WOF ( $15.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(8) $61 / 4 "(15.88 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares
(1) $5 \frac{1}{1 / 8 "} \times$ WOF ( $13.02 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(2) $5^{1 / 8 "}$ " $(13.02 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

## Fabric J, cut:

(1) 6 " $\times$ WOF ( $15.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(4) 6" $(15.24 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares
(1) $5^{1 / 8 "} \times$ WOF ( $13.02 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(2) $5^{1 / 8 "}(13.02 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

## Fabrics K, cut:

(1) 6 " $\times$ WOF ( $15.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut lengthwise (8) Piece 1, (4) with the deer up and (4) with the deer down (see Quilt Layout)

## Fabric L, cut:

(2) 6" x WOF; sub-cut crosswise
(4) Piece 1 deer left facing and (4) Piece 1, with deer right facing (see Quilt Layout on page 5)

## Fabric M, cut:

(2) $6^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $15.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(8) $6 \frac{1}{4} " 1(15.88 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.
(1) $5^{1 / 8 "} \times$ WOF ( $13.02 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (2) $5 \frac{1}{8}$ " $(13.02 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

## Fabric $\mathbf{N}$, cut:

(2) $6^{1 / 4} 4 \times$ WOF $(15.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (8) $6 \frac{1}{4} "(15.88 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.

## Fabric O, cut:

$21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ bias strips to make 250 " ( 635 cm ) finished binding

## Sewing

All seam allowances are $1 / 4 "(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Place a $5^{1 / 8 "}(13.02 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric E square right sides together with each of $51 / 8$ " $(13.02 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric H, I, J, and M squares. Sew $1 / 44^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of the marked line. Cut the unit in half on the original drawn line to create (2) half-square triangle units (HST) (Fig. 1). Make (4) of each fabric pair. Trim each HST to $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$.

2. Noting the orientation of the one-way print, arrange the HST into (4) rows of (4) units each. Sew the blocks together in each row using a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ seam, then sew the rows together, matching adjacent seams, to complete the Center Block (Fig. 2).

Make 1 Center Block
3. Place a $6^{1 / 1 / 4 " ~}(15.87 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $\mathbf{N}$ square right sides together with a $6^{1 / 4}{ }^{\prime \prime}(15.88 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric I square. Sew $1 / 4 "(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of the marked line. Cut the unit in half on the original drawn line to create (2) half-square triangle units (HST). Make a total of (16).
4. Repeat Step 3 with the $6 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}(15.88 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $\mathbf{M}$ and $\mathbf{H}$ squares. Make a total of (16) (Fig. 3).

5. Sew (1) Fabric B Piece 2 to each side of (1) Fabric K Piece 1. Make a total of (8) units(4) of each direction.
6. Sew (1) Fabric A Piece 2 to each side of (1) Fabric L Piece 1. Make a total of (8) units(4) of each direction (Fig. 4).

## Quilt Top Assembly

7. Follow the Quilt Layout diagram on page 5 to lay out the center block with the units created above and the Fabrics $\mathbf{C}$ and $\mathbf{D}$ rectangles.
8. Noting the orientation, add (1) unit to each side of the center block, then to the top and bottom. Continue working outward in this manner, matching adjacent seams, to complete the quilt top.

## Finishing

9. Sew together the $2^{1 / 2 " 1}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ bias Fabric $\mathbf{O}$ binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
10. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
11. Leaving an 8 " $(20.32 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12 " $(30.48 \mathrm{~cm})$ from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
12. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
