Dies Needed:

GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block (55775)

• GO! Square—3-1/2"(3" finished) (Shape 1)

GO! Qube 6" Companion Set – Angles (55788)

- GO! Triangles in Square-Center—3" finished square (Shape 13)
- GO! Triangles in Square-Side—3" finished square (Shape 14)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Dinosaur Medley (55213)
- GO! Strip Cutter—1-1/2" (1" finished) (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter—2-1/2" (2" finished) (55014 or 55017)
- GO! Strip Cutter—3-1/2" (3" finished) (55032)

Fabric Requirements:

White	1/2 yard	
Gray	1/2 yard	
White Multi	3/4 yard	
Green, Yellow, and	1/4 yard of EACH color	
Orange		
Black	1/2 yard	
Batting	39" x 45"	
Backing	41" x 47"	
Fusible	1/2 yard	

NOTE: apply fusible web to wrong side of appliqué fabrics per manufactures' instructions before die cutting shapes.





Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
White and Gray	GO! Square3- 1/2 (3" finished) (Shape 1)	Cut 4—4" x width of fabric (WOF) strips of EACH color. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 33—3" finished squares of EACH color.
Green, Yellow, and Orange	GO! Triangle in Square-Center (3" finished square) (Shape 13)	Cut 1—4" x WOF strip from EACH color. Use Cut & Flip™ method. Sub cut into 11—3" finished Triangle in Square-Center from EACH color.
White Multi	GO! Triangle in Square-Side (3" finished square) (Shape 14)	Cut 4—2-3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 33 and 33 Reversed—3" finished Triangle in Square-Side.
Green, Yellow, Orange and Black	GO! Dinosaur Medley (55213)	Cut 3 Green Dinosaurs. Cut 3 Yellow Dinosaurs. Cut 3 Orange Dinosaurs. Cut 9 Black eyes.
Black	GO! Strip Cutter 1-1/2" (1" finished)	Cut 4—1-1/2" x WOF strips for inner border.
Black	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" finished)	Cut 4—2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.
White Multi	GO! Strip Cutter 4-1/2" (4" finished)	Cut 4—4-1/2" x WOF strips for outer border.






Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

Petrified Forest

NOTE: Directions will be for one 9" finished block. Make 9 blocks.

- 1. Arrange one and one reversed white multi 3" finished triangle in square-side (Shape 14) on opposite side of one green 3" finished triangle in square-center (Shape 13) as shown. Pin and sew. Make 1 green Triangle in Square (TIS) unit. Repeat to make 1 orange and 1 yellow TIS unit.
- 2. Arrange one green, one orange and one yellow TIS unit as shown. Pin and sew. Make 1 tree row.
- 3. Arrange two white and one gray 3-1/2" squares (3" finished) (Shape 1) as shown. Pin and sew. Make 1 center row.
- 4. Arrange two gray and one white 3-1/2" squares (3" finished) (Shape 1) as shown. Pin and sew. Make 1 bottom row.
- 5. Arrange tree, center and bottom rows as shown. Pin and sew. Make 1 Petrified Forest block.
- 6. Arrange appliqué shapes on Petrified Forest block as shown. Fuse into place per manufactures' instructions. Secure shapes using stitch of choice—straight, narrow zig-zag or blanket stitch. Or use embroidery file HERE.







Row Filler Blocks

NOTE: additional filler blocks will be needed to complete the vertical block rows. Make as directed below.

- 1. Arrange one and one reversed white multi 3" finished triangle in square-side (Shape 14) on opposite side of one green 3" finished triangle in square-center (Shape 13) as shown. Pin and sew. Make 1 green Triangle in Square (TIS) unit. Repeat to make a total of 2 green, 2 orange and 2 yellow TIS units.
- 2. Arrange one green, one orange and one yellow TIS unit as shown. Pin and sew. Make 2 tree rows—one will be vertical row two filler block.
- 3. Arrange two white and one gray 3-1/2" squares (3" finished) (Shape 1) as shown. Pin and sew. Make 2 white/gray/white rows.
- 4. Arrange two gray and one white 3-1/2" squares (3" finished) (Shape 1) as shown. Pin and sew. Make 2 gray/white/gray rows—one will be vertical row two filler block.
- 5. Arrange one tree and one white/gray/white row as shown. Pin and sew. Make 1 vertical row one filler block.
- 6. Arrange one white/gray/white and one gray/white/gray row as shown. Pin and sew. Make 1 vertical row three filler block.




























Assemble the Quilt Top

- 1. Lay out blocks and filler blocks into 3 vertical rows as shown. Pay close attention to filler blocks!! Pin and sew. Press seams open.
- 2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions.
- 3. Measure quilt center top to bottom. Cut 2 inner border strips to that length. Sew to right and left sides of quilt center. Press to border.
- 4. Measure quilt center right to left. Cut 2 inner border strips to that length. Sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Press to border.
- 5. Measure quilt center top to bottom. Cut 2 outer border strips to that length. Sew to right and left sides of quilt center. Press to border.
- 6. Measure quilt center right to left. Cut 2 outer border strips to that length. Sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Press to border. Make 1 quilt top.



Quilting and Finishing

- Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- Pin or baste layers together. 2.
- Quilt as desired. 3
- Add binding, mitering corners.
