Finished Size: 32" x 40"

- GO! Coffee and Tea Medley (55212)
- GO! Big Circle-4", 6", 7", 8" (55462)
- GO! Circle-1/2", 3/4", 1" 1-1/4" (55484)
- GO! Square Cutter 2" (1-1/2" Finished) (55702)
- GO! Square Cutter 1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55470)
- GO! Strip Cutter 1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter 2" (1-1/2" Finished) (55025)
- GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

(G) Ovals-Purple	1/2 yard
(H) Hands-Black/Royal	5/8 yard
(I) Paisley-Aqua	1/3 yard
(J) Hands-Black/Olive	5/8 yard
Backing	1-1/2 yards
Fusible	1/2 yard

Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
(A) Flower & Vine-Aqua		Cut 2—7-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Sub cut 6— 7-1/2" squares.
(B) Gray	GO! Big Circle 4", 6", 7", 8" die (55462)	*Cut 1—7" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 7" widths. Sub cut 6— 6" circles.
(B) Gray	GO! Coffee and Tea Medley (55212)	*Cut 1—3-1/2" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut 6—Coffee Cups.
(C) White	GO! Big Circle 4", 6", 7", 8" die (55462)	*Cut 1—7" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 7" widths. Sub cut 6— 6" circles.
(C) White	GO! Strip Cutter 2" (1-1/2" Finished) (55025)	Cut 1—8-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub cut 4—2" strips. Cut 2 strips to measure 2" x 33-1/2" and 2 strips to measure 2" x 28-1/2"
(C) White	GO! Coffee and Tea Medley (55212)	*Cut 1—3" x WOF strip. Sub cut into 4-1/2" widths. Sub cut 4—Teacups with the fabric facing up and 2—Teacups with the fabric facing down. *Cut 1—2" x WOF strip. Sub cut into 4-1/2" widths. Sub cut 4—Teacup Saucers with the fabric facing up and 2—Teacup Saucers with the fabric facing down.
(D) Medallions-Fuchsia	GO! Square 1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55470)	Cut 1—6" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 6" widths. Sub cut 20—1-1/2" squares.
(D) Medallions-Fuchsia	GO! Square 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55709)	Cut 1—6" square. Sub cut 4— 2-1/2" squares
(D) Medallions-Fuchsia	GO! Circle 1/2", 3/4", 1", 1-1/4" (55484)	*Cut 1—2-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 5-1/2" widths. Sub cut 36—3/4" Circles.

(E) Flower & Vines-Lime	GO! Coffee and Tea Medley (55212)	*Cut 1—2" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut 6—Coffee Cup Bands.
(F) Packed Flowers-Teal	GO! Coffee and Tea Medley (55212)	*Cut 1—1" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut 6—Coffee Cup Lids.
(F) Packed Flowers-Teal	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017)	Cut 1—8-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" strips.
(G) Ovals-Purple		Cut 2—7-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Sub cut 6— 7-1/2" squares.
(H) Hands-Black/Royal	GO! Strip Cutter 1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 2—8-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub cut 7—1-1/2" strips. Sub cut 31— 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips.
(I) Paisley-Aqua	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017)	Cut 1—8-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" strips.
(J) Hands-Black/Olive	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017)	Cut 2—8-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub cut 4—2-1/2" strips for the binding.
Back		Cut 1—40" x 48" piece for the backing.

**Following the manufacturer's instructions, apply fusible web to the wrong side of the fabric before die cutting the shape.*

Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

1. Following the Manufacturer's instruction, press six 3/4" Fabric D circles to (1) left handed Fabric C teacup as shown in Figure 1. Trim any circles that hang off the edge of teacup as needed to make (1) Teacup #1. Repeat to make (4) Teacup #1 pieces.
2. Repeat Step 1 with (2) right handed Fabric C teacups and remaining 3/4" Fabric D circles to make (2) Teacup #2 pieces (Fig. 2).
3. Center and Press (1) 6" Fabric B circle to (1) 7-1/2" Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.
4. Press (1) Teacup #1 and matching saucer to the center of (1) Unit 1 Block to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block One Squares.
5. Press (1) Teacup #2 and matching saucer to the center of (1) Unit 1 Block to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (2) Block Two Squares

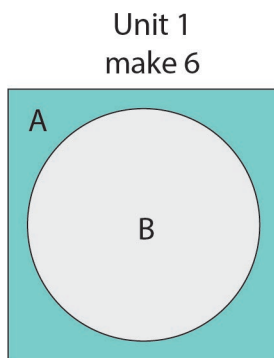

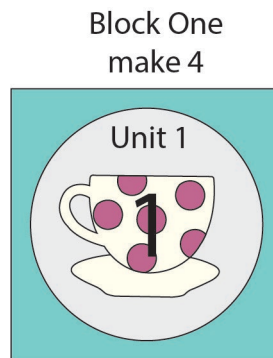

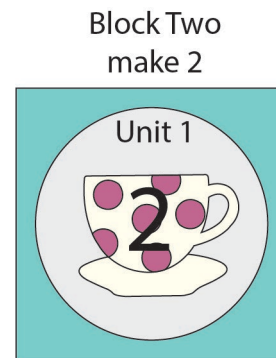

6. Center and Press (1) 6" Fabric C circle to (1) 7-1/2" Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.
7. Press (1) Coffee Cup, (1) Coffee Cup Band and (1) Coffee Cup Lid to the center of (1) Unit 2 Block to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (6) Block Three squares.
8. Finish the raw edges of each shape on Block One, Block Two and Block Three squares with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
9. Sew together (4) 1-1/2" Fabric D squares and (3) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric H strips to make (1) Sashing Strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (5) Sashing strips total.

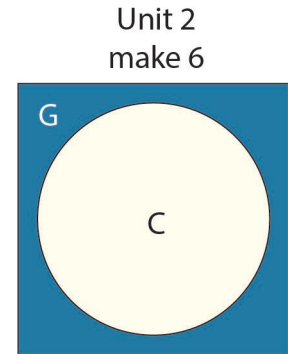

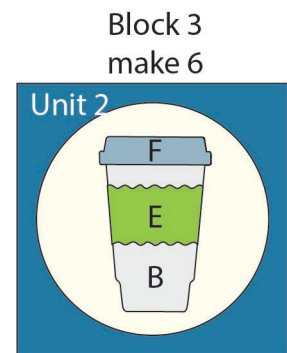

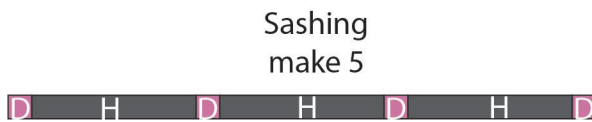

10. Follow Figure 9 to sew together (4) Block One squares, (2) Block Two squares, (6) Block Three squares, (5) Sashing Rows and (16) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric H strips to make the Center Block.

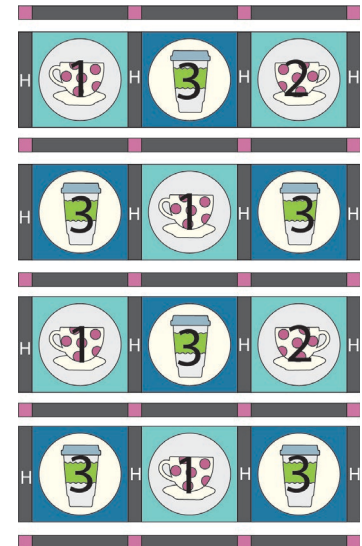

11. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip and (1) 2-1/2" x WOF fabric I strip, lengthwise to make (1) strip set (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (2) strip sets total.
12. Cut (2) strips set into (32) 2-1/2" Unit 3 strips (Fig. 11).
13. Sew together (7) Unit 3 strips. Sew (1) 2-1/2" Fabric D square on each end of the sewn units to make the Top Border (Fig. 12). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.
14. Sew together (9) Unit 3 strips to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 13). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

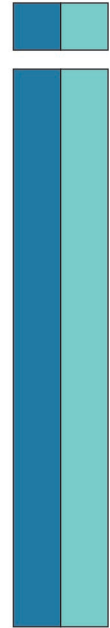

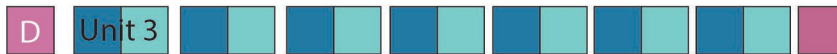

Quilt Top (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling)

1. Sew (1) 2" x 33-1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) 2" x 28-1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the center block.
2. Sew (1) Side Border from Step 14, to each side of the center block.
3. Sew the Top and Bottom borders from Step 13 to the center block.

Quilting and Finishing

4. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
5. Pin or baste layers together.
6. Quilt as desired.
7. Add binding, mitering corners.
