| <b>1. Identify something that hurts</b> —perhaps that you are having a hard time forgiving someone for. (Consider loneliness, abandonment, abuse, neglect, unfair criticism, rejection, ridicule, etc.) |

| —Lord, when did you experience something like this?   |

| 4. Thank Jesus for His compassion and comfort.  |
| Dear Lord Jesus, thank you for caring so much about me that you are moved with compassion for my pain. Thank you that you understand and that you care.   |
| 5. As needed, choose to forgive the offender.   |
