State of Wisconsin – LRB-3156/1

LRB-3156/1: This bill prohibits University of Wisconsin System institutions and technical colleges from requiring students or prospective students to be tested for, or receive a vaccine against, the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, which causes COVID-19, as a condition of attendance or presence on campus.

These medical procedure decisions should NEVER be a condition for education. Dear Representative / Senator,

I am writing to request your support for LRB-3156/1 which will prohibit University of Wisconsin institutions and technical colleges from requiring students be tested for, or receive a vaccine against, SARS-CoV2 coronavirus as a condition of attendance.
