# Working with Trauma & Complex Cases: A Schema Therapy-Informed Approach to Formulation & Treatment

Schema therapy (ST) is an integrative, transdiagnostic approach that focuses on healing clients' painful schemas and maladaptive modes. ST was developed by Dr Jeffrey Young in the 1980s for clients diagnosed with Borderline Personality Disorder, but has since been modified and adapted to work with any long-term or hard-to-treat psychological difficulties. It offers a sophisticated, highly effective approach to working with complex cases — especially for clients with a history of trauma, abuse or neglect who may present with substance misuse, chronic depression or anxiety disorder, self-harm, suicidal behaviour, attachment or dissociative disorder, eating disorder or lifelong relationship difficulties.

The core concept in ST is 'limited reparenting', which involves providing a corrective emotional experience for clients; meeting core needs that were not met in childhood; and becoming a 'secure base' for clients, providing safety, warmth and compassion to heal painful childhood wounds through the therapeutic relationship. This approach is paired with 'empathic confrontation' of maladaptive modes and behaviours, both in-session and the way they impact clients' everyday lives.

This one-day workshop will offer an introduction to the history and theory of ST, as well as the 18 Early Maladaptive Schemas and maladaptive modes; explain why attachment is key with traumatised or highly complex clients; how limited reparenting/empathic confrontation work in practice; and how you can use experiential techniques such as imagery, chair work and relational techniques to heal your clients' painful schemas and free them from habitual, unhelpful ways of thinking and behaving.

The day will be a combination of didactic teaching, video and live demonstrations, small-group discussion and skills practice.

In this workshop participants will:

- Gain a good initial understanding of the schema therapy model
- Learn how to apply ST-informed ways of formulating and treating complex cases in their own practice or service
- Be able to draw up a Mode Map to formulate a client's schemas and modes bringing structure and simplicity to cases with multiple diagnoses and high levels of complexity

•	Understand why developing a secure attachment is key when working with highly
	complex clients

• Experience powerful techniques such as imagery and chair work – and learn key techniques to apply in their own work
