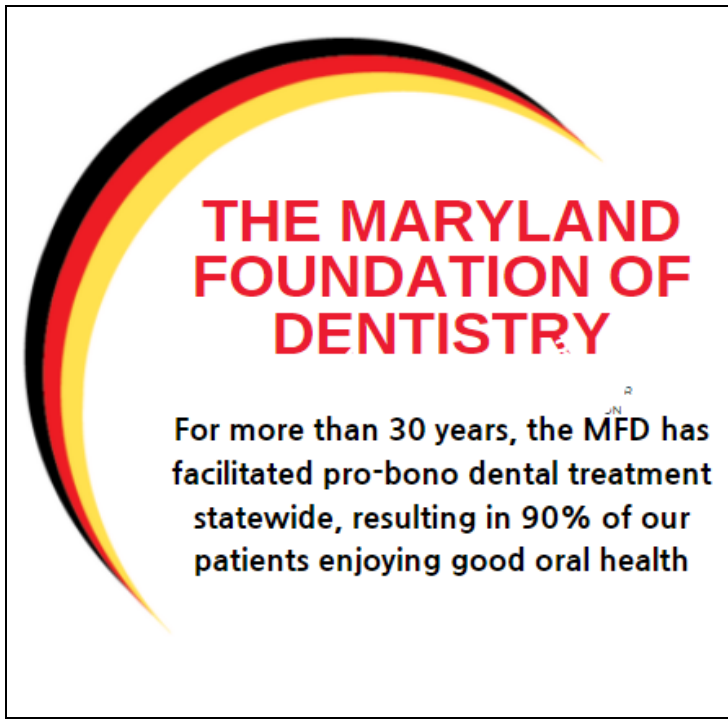


Patient FAQ

To be eligible you must apply and be accepted into the program. You must be a Maryland adult (18+years) with an intellectual, physical, or developmental disability and be unable to pay for your dental care. Those with private dental insurance are not eligible for this program.

All dental treatment and labs are provided at no cost to you in a private dental office.

At the completion of treatment you will have improved oral health which will help your physical, social and emotional well-being.

All patients accepted into the program must provide transportation to and from the dental office and must keep ALL appointments.

The MFD does NOT provide emergency services.
