

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MARINA CLUB WATERFRONT ASSOCIATION, INC

in the Office of the Secretary of State of Texas MAY 1 5 1995

Corporations Section

ARTICLE ONE: NAME

The name of the corporation is "Marina Club Waterfront Association, Inc."

ARTICLE TWO: NON-PROFIT

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE: DURATION

The period of its duration is perpensal.

ARTICLE FOUR: PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Association is organized are to own a boatdock facility on Lake Austin, Texas and represent the interests of Members of the Marina Club Waterfront Association, Inc., each of whom will be a member of the Marina Club Homeowners Association, Inc., a Texas non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE FIVE: MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall be a membership corporation. The qualifications for membership and rights, duties and obligations of members shall be contained in the Bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE SIX: REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The name of its initial registered agent is Liany Niemann, and the street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1122 Colorado Street, Suite 313, Austin, Texas 78701.

ARTICLE SEVEN: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors in which shall reside all rights, powers, authority and responsibility with respect to the management and affairs of the corporation. The initial Board shall consist of

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall, after the Corporate Charter has been issued, be elected pursuant to the Bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE EIGHT: INDEMNIFICATION

The exponence shall indennify vary director or officer or former director or officer of the corporation for exponent and come (including automory's fami) actually and necessarily incurred by him in connection with any claim assured against the director or officer, by ection in court or otherwise, by reason of being or having been the director or officer, except in relation to manure as so which the officer or director is guilty of gross negligence or willful miscopolute in respect of the matter in which indemnity is sought.

ARTICLE NINE: LIMITED LIABILITY

The members of the Board of Directors, the officers of the corporation, and committee members of the Association shall not be liable to any member or any person claiming by or through any member for any set or omission of the director or officer's act or omission is (1) a breach of a dary of loyalty to the corporation or its members, (2) as not or omission not in good fisth or that involves intentional missonature or a knowing violation of law, (3) a measuring from which a director or officer receives an improper benefit, whether or not the benefit resulted from an action taken within the scope of the person's office, or (4) as act or omission for which the liability of the director is expressly provided for by a statute. The corporation shall indemnify all such directors and officers from all claims, demands, actions and proceedings and any expenses in connection therewith except if the director or officer has seed in violation of the foregoing. The Board of Directors may purchase (but is not requested to purchase) directors and officers liability insurance.
