



Aerial Application Rating – Spraying

Prior to commencing your Aerial Application course of training, you are to have passed a theoretical examination. This examination is conducted by ASL and has a pass of 75% which is to be completed within two (2) hours.

Your initial induction would incorporate compiling a student training folder and covering the requirements of the Aerial Application course.

The course is structured to cover the lesson plan and comprises of fifteen (15) hours of instruction including the Pre Rating Test. The Rating Flight Test is in addition to the training hours laid out in the syllabus of training.

Each lesson involves a theory brief covering the upcoming lesson, including operational, hazards and TEM.

During the practical course of training, you will be assessed to ensure competency and upon successful completion of the course you will be issued a Certificate of Achievement.
