



# Intermountain<sup>®</sup> Primary Children's Hospital Coming soon to Lehi



The pediatric population of Utah County is growing rapidly – in fact, some estimates predict that it will be equal to Salt Lake County's by the year 2040. With this expected rise in the number of growing families, so too comes an urgent need for high-quality, comprehensive pediatric care.

In our quest to **build the nation's model health system for children**, Intermountain Healthcare has made a promise to meet this urgent need for pediatric services through innovative programs, initiatives, and facilities – one of which includes the construction of a second Primary Children's Hospital in Lehi.





The planned 38-acre campus near 3300 West 2100 North will feature five floors, 66 beds, a three-story medical office building, and 468,000 total square feet. Care will be delivered by a medical team fully integrated with Primary Children’s Hospital in Salt Lake City.



Expected to open in 2023, the hospital will house trauma, emergency, intensive care, surgical, inpatient mental health, Safe and Healthy Families Clinic, sleep medicine, infusion, rehabilitation, other outpatient services, and a patient and family-friendly environment.
